There is a lot to see around Chicago. Our tour will start with the biggest industrial city of Wisconsin---Milwaukee, birthplace of Harley-Davidson motorcycles. Visit Harley-Davidson Museum and check out the history of the legendary motorcycle brand from the collection of 450 motorcycles and artifacts including the oldest known Harley-Davidson motorcycle.

Visit the beautiful campus of the Northwestern University. It is one of the best universities in the States with more than 150 years of history, ranking the 14th in America and 30th in the world.

We will then visit the Bahá'í House of Worship in Wilmette, Illinois. It is the oldest surviving Bahá'í House of Worship in the world, and the only one in the United States. Three core principles establish a basis for Bahá'í teachings and doctrine: the unity of God, the unity of religion, and the unity of humanity.

We will also see The Harris Bradley Center, home court of NBA home team Milwaukee Bucks and the St. Joseph's Catholic Church.
