Day 1: Home – Washington, D.C.

The first day itinerary is for your reference only; the schedule is subject to change upon your arrival. Thanks for choosing your vacation with us! Arriving at Dulles International Airport (IAD), our tour guide will meet you at the Baggage Claim area. Take our shuttle to the hotel and catch some rest. Complimentary group airport pick-up service is provided 9:00AM - 10:00PM. For the other time, paid pick-up service is also available for the first two persons at \$120 with \$10 for each additional person. For those who arrive before 5:00PM, you are invited to join our Washington Night Tour at \$25/person. . (*Night tour requires at least 4 guests enrolled.)

*Washington Night Tour:

When the night falls, Washington turns into a different city. See all the major sights and monuments of Washington DC lit up for the night on this comprehensive tour of the nation's capital. With enjoyment of

the tranquility, our tour will include the Air Force Memorial where you can easily overlook the Pentagon and the skyline of the capitol city, the waterside of Reflecting Pool where you can look up at the gorgeous U.S. Capitol building and National Mall (also known as Capitol Hill), the columned rotunda of Jefferson Memorial and the WWII Memorial where you can also oversee the grand Lincoln Memorial.

Day 2: Washington, D.C. – Amish – Philadelphia – NYC Night Tour*

We are going to Lancaster and visit an Amish Village. The Amish are a group of traditionalist Christian church fellowships from Swiss Anabaptist origins. Today, the most traditional descendants of the Amish continue to speak Pennsylvania German, also known as "Pennsylvania Dutch". Despite the development of the contemporary technologies in the 21st century, the rules of the church must be observed by every member and cover most aspects of day-to-day living, including prohibitions or limitations on the use of power-line electricity, telephones, and automobiles, as well as regulations on clothing. Most Amish do not buy commercial insurance or participate in Social Security. As present-day Anabaptists, Amish church members practice nonresistance and will not perform any type of military service. Amish life is always remarkable in the trip with such a huge contrast to the modern social values. Later, we will enjoy a special authentic Amish lunch.

Next, we will visit Philadelphia where recognized as the birthplace of American democracy. At the Independence National Historical Park, tour guide will arrange a free time for guests to walk around. Inside the Independence Hall, you will have a special moment of standing exactly where the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution were signed. You also won't miss the Liberty Bell which is recognized for its famous crack. Go beyond the iconic crack to learn how this State House bell was transformed into an extraordinary symbol. You will also see the Statue of Washington, Congress Hall, and many other great attractions. (According to the traffic, weather and time of the day, guests may have chance to visit One Liberty Observation Deck, which is the only observation deck in Philadelphia. Guests will stand on the shoulder of Philadelphia's 'giant', Benjamin Franklin, to see the historic city through a splendid 360-degree view).

In the evening, upon arrival in New York, you are invited to join our delicately tailored New York City Night Tour that accesses you to stunning views of the "Sleepless Town" at \$25/person. (*Night tour requires at least 4 guests enrolled.)

*New York Night Tour:

Start from Rockefeller Center, you will be led sightseeing multiple NYC landmarks including Times Square. Additionally, Hudson Riverside from New Jersey is one of the best locations to have a panoramic night view of the New York City.

Day 3: New York City Tour

Our highly organized tour is particularly designed for you to learn more of the city's unique history. culture, and the core spirit of the New Yorkers! In the morning, we will start the tour at the world's financial and securities trading center, Wall Street, taking pictures with Trinity Church, New York Stock Exchange and its signature sculpture Charging Bull. Later, by stepping up to the Empire State Building Observation deck, guests could overlook the panoramic view of the central park and New York City. Empire State Building stood as the world's tallest building for nearly 40 years, and has been surpassed in late 1970. Its name is derived from the nickname of New York, the Empire State. Nowadays it is still the most famed landmark of the city. Also, Guests will take a sightseeing cruise tour on the Hudson River to enjoy the city view from a totally different angle, as well as take pictures with the backdrops of Statue of Liberty and Brooklyn Bridge. Furthermore, visit USS Intrepid, the legendary aircraft carrier and national heritage that costs \$120 million, which is reopen for visitors. Concorde supersonic airliner, the space shuttle Enterprise, the world's fastest jets and a guided missile submarine will be also featured in the exhibition. In the end of the day, our tour bus will pass by the Fifth Avenue, and Rockefeller Center. By stopping at Times square and Broadway, you will have a chance to visit EITHER Madame Tussauds to take pictures with the famous, OR the Ripley's Believe It or Not which is perfect for those who want to immerse themselves in the unusual and the unexpected.

Day 4: Washington, D.C. – Home

We will firstly visit National Mall (also known as the Capitol Hill), which is between the Lincoln Memorial and the United States Capitol. The National Mall sees millions of visitors and protestors every year, but it has also played as host to many history-making events. We will visit the Lincoln Memorial. This grand monument overlooks the Reflecting Pool, the Washington Monument and the U.S. Capitol. Inside, the 19-foot marble statue of the 16th president is flanked by inscriptions of his Second Inaugural Address and the famous Gettysburg Address. Our tour will also stop at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial and the Korean War Memorial. The two monuments honor members of the U.S. armed forces who fought in the wars. In the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum, we will take a glance at the human aviation and space heritage as well as have a vision of space travel in the future through thousands of objects on display, including the 1903 Wright Flyer, Charles Lindbergh's Spirit of St. Louis, the Apollo 11 Command Module Columbia, and a lunar rock you can touch. Furthermore, we can take photos with backdrops of the White House and the U.S. Capitol due to the visit limitation for the public. You surely don't want to miss the opportunity to take our exclusive DC cruise for sightseeing of the town along the Potomac River. Along the way of our tour, you will also see and pass by the Thomas Jefferson Memorial, WWII Memorial and more.
