Day 1: Hometown – NYC (Self-guided tour in Flushing) (12/25 Tue)

Hotel: Crowne (Ramada) Plaza EWR /Sheraton Edison/Doubletree Somerset or equivalent

The first day itinerary is for your reference only; the schedule is subject to change upon your arrival.

Thanks for choosing your vacation with us! You can choose any one of the major airports in New York City (JFK, LGA, EWR) when you book your flight. Our professional tour guide will meet you at the

baggage claim area for the domestic flight; for international flight, please arrive at the Passenger Waiting Area for pick up. (Passengers, who arrive at Terminal 7of JFK Airport, please wait outside of the baggage claim area.)

- Guests who arrive at JFK or LGA airport before 5:00pm will be sent to Flushing Queens. We will
 provide free luggage storage service, and our guests can visit nearby Queens Crossing, Macy's
 Shopping Center. In addition, Flushing is a safe and booming Asian commercial and retail area
 with many shopping and dining options. You will experience the distinctive Asian-American
 culture.
- 2. For those who arrive at EWR airport, feel free to take our shuttle to Jersey Garden Outlet and we will take you back to the hotel as soon as the rooms are ready to check-in.

- Itinerary: DUMBO (20 mins) → Madison Square & Flatiron Building (Outside view, 20 mins)
 → Washington Square & New York University (Outside view, 15 mins)

DUMBO is a neighborhood in the New York City borough of Brooklyn. On December 18, 2007, the New York City Landmarks Preservation Commission voted unanimously to designate Dumbo as the city's 90th historic district.

The Flatiron building has been called "one of the world's most iconic skyscrapers and a quintessential symbol of New York City", anchors the south (downtown) end of Madison Square and the north (uptown) end of the Ladies' Mile Historic District. The neighborhood around it is called the Flatiron District after its signature building, which has become an icon of New York City. Washington Square Park is an open space, dominated by the Washington Square Arch at the northern gateway to the park, with a tradition of celebrating nonconformity. The park's fountain area has long been one of the city's popular spots for residents and tourists. Most of the buildings surrounding the park now belong to New York University.

New York Night Tour

- All guests who arrive before 4:30PM can join our tailored night tour to experience the charm of "the city that never sleeps"

- Itinerary: Rockefeller Center (15 mins) \rightarrow Times Square (30 mins) \rightarrow An observation point in NJ (15 mins)

Rockefeller Center is described as one of the greatest projects of the Great Depression era, Rockefeller Center was declared a New York City landmark in 1985 and a National Historic Landmark in 1987.

Times Square is a major commercial intersection, tourist destination, entertainment center and neighborhood. One of the world's busiest pedestrian areas. And it's very charming at night. **Great observation point in NJ**, high up on the cliffs overlooking the Hudson River. There, you will enjoy what is considered to be the best night view of the New York City skyline.

Day 2: New York City Tour (12/26 Wed)

At a first glance, travelling around the entire of New York City seems like the mission impossible; however, our highly organized tour is especially designed for you: by visiting amounts of famous landmarks, you will learn more of the city's unique history, culture, and the core spirit of the New Yorkers! By stepping up to the Empire State Building Observation deck, guests could overlook the beautiful view of the central park and the entire of New York City. Empire State Building stood as the world's tallest building for nearly 40 years and has been surpassed in late 1970. Its name is derived from the nickname of New York, the Empire State. Nowadays it is still the most famed landmark of the city. Also, Guests will take a sightseeing cruise tour on the Hudson River to enjoy the city view from a totally different angle, as well as take pictures with the backdrops of Statue of Liberty and Brooklyn Bridge. Furthermore, visit USS Intrepid, the national heritage that costs \$120 million, which is reopen for visitors. Concorde supersonic airliner and a variety of aircrafts will be all in the exhibition. In addition, wandering around the world's famous financial and securities trading center - Wall Street, taking pictures with Trinity Church, New York Stock Exchange and its signature sculpture Charging Bull, and visiting the "Crossroads of the world" Times Square. Of course, we can't miss the renowned Metropolitan Museum of Art. The Metropolitan Museum of Art is the largest art museum in the United States with collections of more than 2 million works of art. In the end of the day, our tour bus will pass by the Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller Center, Ground Zero and the new "Freedom tower" - One World Trade Center.

Certainly, Broadway musicals are one of the most celebrated symbols of the city. You will have a chance to watch the world class Broadway shows of opening after 7:00PM upon your request. (Note: the admission is on your own expense, and you can book tickets from tour guide in advance owing to seats are limited.) (If you book the Broadway show tickets with us, we will provide \$100 drop-off service for free!)

Day 3: Princeton - Philadelphia - Washington D.C. (12/27 Thu)

Hotel: Holiday Inn/BW Premier Harrisburg/Four Points/ Courtyard or equivalent

In the morning, we will visit Princeton University, one of the prestigious Ivy League universities in United States. A guided campus tour will give our guests the opportunity to know more about American education culture. Then we will head to the National Independence Historical Park in Philadelphia. While walking on the cobblestone streets, it seems that you could still hear the rings by the Liberty Bell, which has witnessed the founding history of America. Independence Hall (exterior, reverse side of \$100 bill), is the birthplace of American modern democracy, where the Declaration of the Independence and the Constitution was debated and adopted. Next, we will go to the One Liberty Observation Deck, standing on the top of Philly and enjoy the stunning view of the first capital of US. In the afternoon, we will head to Washington D.C., and visit the Madame Tussands in Washington D.C. which is the only attraction you can get close to the "44 presidents" of US. We will have the chance to explore the inner structure of The White House, taking photographs with Oval Office desk aka The Resolute Desk. The great names will be memorized and honored forever. Next, we will visit the White House (exterior, reverse side of \$20 Bill). We will also visit the U.S. Department of Treasury (exterior, reverse side of \$10 Bill), Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial and Vietnam War Memorial. Lincoln Memorial (reverse side of \$5 Bill) is built in recognition of the great efforts of President Abraham Lincoln for American human rights, and the famous speech "I Have a Dream" by Martin Luther King Jr. take place right outside Lincoln Memorial. (Due to effect of early sunset during winter time, we will visit Lincoln Memorial after dusk.)

Day 4: Washington D.C. – New York (12/28 Fri)

Hotel: Hyatt Regency New Brunswick/The Heldrich Hotel & Conference Center or equivalent

Depart from the hotel in early morning, we will first visit the US Capitol (reverse side of \$50 bill). The U.S. Capitol was established at 1793, it has become the symbol of American people and government (Only outside visiting while it's not open to public, usually on public holidays and Sundays). We will also visit the Library of Congress (exterior), which has served the United States congress for more than 200 years, and Supreme Court of the United States (exterior). After that, we will take the D.C. Cruise along Potomac River to see many of the areas' most historic landmarks and memorials in a unique way. If time permit, we will also visit Newseum, a top 10 ranked popular attraction in Washington D.C. It's known as one of the most interactive museum in the world that promotes free expression and the First Amendment to the United States Constitution. The Newseum experience traces the evolution of electronic communication from the birth of radio, to the technologies of the present and the future. In addition, along the way, you will see the Washington Monument, the World War II Memorial, the Thomas Jefferson Memorial and etc. After we depart from Washington D.C., we will pass by DCA and head back to New York.

Day 5: New York - New haven - Rhode Island (12/29 Sat)

Hotel: Doubletree by Hilton/Four Points by Sheraton/Radisson or equivalent

In the morning, we will visit New Haven, Connecticut, Yale University, which was founded in 1701. Yale University is the nation's third oldest institution of higher learning in the Ivy League this belongs to the ancient university campus leisurely stroll. With the Yale University tour guide (Self Expense), you will have an amazing campus tour experience of the school. Then we will head to Newport, Rhode Island. Through the famous Newport Bridge, you will see the luxurious The Breakers mansion. Here, we can personally experience the glory of the American gold rush era of wealth. The 1895 mansion was patterned after a Renaissance palace. No matter the unique decoration of the building or the delicate artworks were all handcrafted in Europe then shipped to the location. Arrive in Boston, you will have the opportunity to enjoy Boston's most famous feast – Lobster.

Day 6: Boston – New York (12/30 Sun)

Hotel: Hyatt Regency New Brunswick/The Heldrich Hotel & Conference Center or equivalent

The trip will start in the city of Cambridge, MA where we will visit the Harvard University. Here, you will find Harvard's oldest campus and take pictures with the statue of John Harvard, known as the "Statue of Three Lies". Also, we will take pictures with the main academic building inside MIT. Another fun will begin as soon as you board the cruise ship and enjoy a breathtaking view of the Boston harbor. Later, go sightseeing in the Boston city. We will pass by the old Trinity Cathedral, the Hancock Building, the Boston Park, Prudential Center, and Boston Public Library along the way while overlooking the gold dome of the State House. Around the noon, we will arrive at old Quincy Market. Quincy Market is opportune for strolling through, or to get a taste of the historical ambience as well as to pick out souvenirs among the assorted merchants and artisans. The Market is also surrounded by dozens of restaurants for dining option with a variety of authentic cuisines, and Boston's Clam Chowder is always a good choice to satisfy your taste buds! After lunch, we will set off for New York.

Day 7: New York Times Square Countdown (12/31 Mon)

Hotel: Hyatt Regency New Brunswick/The Heldrich Hotel & Conference Center or equivalent

In the morning, we will visit the Central Park of New York and the 5th Ave. You may enjoy Lady M or Luke's Lobster for brunch. We will pass by Trump Tower, Apple Flagship store, and much more high-end brands on 5th Ave (There would be no space for storage shopping bags so please do not purchase any goods on that day). Next, we are heading to the Times Square countdown area, and celebrating New Year with thousands of visitors.
