Day 1

Hometown – NYC (Self-guided tour in Flushing)

Hotel : E Hotel Banquet & Conference Center/Red Roof Inn/Days Inn or equivalent

The first day itinerary is for your reference only; the schedule is subject to change upon your arrival.

Thanks for choosing your vacation with us! You can choose any one of the major airports in New York City (JFK, LGA, EWR) when you book your flight. Our professional tour guide will meet you at the baggage claim area for the domestic flight; for international flight, please arrive at the Passenger Waiting Area for pick up. (Passengers, who arrive at Terminal 7 of JFK Airport, please wait outside of the baggage claim area.)

1. Guests who arrive at JFK or LGA airport before 5:00pm will be sent to Flushing Queens. We will provide free luggage storage service, and our guests can visit nearby Queens Crossing, Macy's Shopping Center. In addition, Flushing is a safe and booming Asian commercial and retail area with many shopping and dining options. You will experience the distinctive Asian-American culture.
2. For those who arrive at EWR airport, feel free to take our shuttle to Jersey Garden Outlet and we will take you back to the hotel as soon as the rooms are ready to check-in.

New York Morning Tour

- For guests who meet tour guide before 9:00AM in JFK or LGA airport, guests can join morning tour.
- Book advanced before landing can enjoy promotion price: \$1/person (Seats guaranteed. If passengers couldn't meet the tour guide before 9:00AM because of flights delay or personal reasons, \$1 will be returned). - **Itinerary: DUMBO (20 mins) → Madison Square & Flatiron Building (Outside view, 20 mins) → Washington Square & New York University (Outside view, 15 mins)**

DUMBO is a neighborhood in the New York City borough of Brooklyn. On December 18, 2007, the New York City Landmarks Preservation Commission voted unanimously to designate Dumbo as the city's 90th historic district.

The Flatiron building has been called "one of the world's most iconic skyscrapers and a quintessential symbol of New York City", anchors the south (downtown) end of Madison Square and the north (uptown) end of the Ladies' Mile Historic District. The neighborhood around it is called the Flatiron District after its signature building, which has become an icon of New York City.

Washington Square Park is an open space, dominated by the Washington Square Arch at the northern gateway to the park, with a tradition of celebrating nonconformity. The park's fountain area has long been one of the city's popular spots for residents and tourists. Most of the buildings surrounding the park now belong to New York University.

New York Night Tour

- All guests who arrive before 4:30PM can join our tailored night tour to experience the charm of "the city that never sleeps"
- Price: \$25/adult and \$15/child. (Complimentary transfer excludes service fee \$10/per person)
- **Itinerary: Rockefeller Center (15 mins) → Times Square (30 mins) → An observation point in NJ (15 mins)**

Rockefeller Center is described as one of the greatest projects of the Great Depression era, Rockefeller Center was declared a New York City landmark in 1985 and a National Historic Landmark in 1987.

Times Square is a major commercial intersection, tourist destination, entertainment center and neighborhood. One of the world's busiest pedestrian areas. And it's very charming at night.

Great observation point in NJ, high up on the cliffs overlooking the Hudson River. There, you will enjoy what is considered to be the best night view of the New York City skyline.

Day 2 **Secret Caverns – Niagara Falls (Night View)**

Hotel : Quality Inn Rochester/Days Inn Batavia or equivalent

In the morning, we will directly head to Secret Caverns. **Secret Caverns** is in upstate New York. A 103-step staircase with various layers of limestone deposited faithfully by the prehistoric ocean is the only way in or out. Many of the caverns in this area were formed largely during the last Ice Age about 38,000-14,000 years ago. "For thousands of years mineral laden water has been precipitating on the walls, ceiling, and floor of the caverns, leaving behind great deposits of golden calcite. When these deposits hang from the ceiling like icicles, they are called stalactites. When they build up from the floor, they are called stalagmites. And when you see calcite dripping down over the walls or covering the rocks, that is called flowstone." – You will have a wonderful time with all the views mentioned! (Note: Due to the cold weather and frozen road since November, Secret Caverns may be closed on some departure date)

From there we will continue to Niagara Falls, NY. You can optionally watch a **Niagara IMAX movie** which chronicles more than 12,000 years of history and examines human interaction with the falls from ancient time through the people - like you - who come to see them today. At night, we will see the **Niagara Falls Illumination**. (*The completeness of night view on certain summer evenings may be limited or not available due to late sunset time and US Federal Government regulations on driving hours.*)

Day 3

Maid of the Mist – Niagara Falls In-depth Tour – Watkins Glen State Park (Mid of May -Oct)
Maid of the Mist – Niagara Falls In-depth Tour – Corning Glass Museum (November -May)

Hotel : Comfort Inn/Red Roof Inn, MD or equivalent

Departure from the hotel in the morning, we will continue to explore Niagara Falls, NY where we will take Niagara Falls In-depth Tour and take the famous Maid of the Mist boat ride (seasonal, summer only)

Niagara Falls In-Depth Tour - This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder - *Niagara Whirlpool State Park* and the U.S. historic landmark - *Old Fort Niagara*. The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It is estimated the whirlpool formed approximately 7,500 years ago by the upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by Niagara River. Old Fort Niagara is a rich historic landmark; it spans more than 300 years. Its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in the French and Indian War, the American Revolution and the War of 1812. The gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort.

Maid of the Mist - It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful. More than 6 million cubic ft. (168,000 cubic meters) of water goes over the crest line of the falls every minute during peak daytime tourist hours. This famous Maid of the Mist ride gets passengers as close as

possible to the Niagara Falls! The Maid rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls.

Mid of May- Oct. After the lunch, our tour will go to the next stop – **Watkins Glen State Park**. Watkins Glen State Park - is the most famous of the Finger Lakes State Parks. Within two miles, the glen's stream descends 400 feet past 200-foot cliffs, generating 19 waterfalls along its course. The gorge path winds over and under waterfalls and through the spray of Cavern Cascade. Rim trails overlook the gorge. It's a perfect park for photography! (**Note: we charge \$10/person for state park admission and bus parking.**) Since November (According to weather condition), Watkins Glen State Park will be closed. We will visit world famous Corning Glass Museum instead.

November -May, After Watkins Glen State Park closed for winter, we will visit **Corning Glass Museum** - in western New York is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. Its collection contains more than 45,000 objects, some of which date back millennia. Guests here will be invited to watch the Hot Glass Show which is performed by professional glass craftsman, and, will have chance to know how ancient Egyptian made the world first glass mask in 3000 years ago!

Day 4

Washington D.C. – Philadelphia – New York City

Hotel : E Hotel Banquet & Conference Center, Red Roof Inn, Days Inn or equivalent

Leave the hotel in early morning; we will go visiting Washington D.C., the capital of the United State.

First, we will visit **National Air and Space Museum**. It records the history of the space industry: from the Wright Brothers' aircrafts in 1903 to modern out space exploration, St. Louis's Lindbergh's Spirit to the real Apollo 11 cockpit. It has the most sufficient documents of aerospace history all over the world.

Next, we will go taking **the DC cruise**; enjoy the scenic view along the Potomac River. (*When the DC cruise closed during winter, we will visit International Spy Museum instead. The museum is a museum exploring the craft, practice, history, and contemporary role of espionage. It is the only public museum in the United States solely dedicated to espionage and the only one in the world to provide a global perspective on an all-but-invisible profession.).

The sightseeing also includes: **Capitol Hill** (outside view), the center of power in this nation which contains the **Congress and House of the Senate and Representatives**. **The White House** (outside view) located at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue, is the living and working place for American President. Additionally, we will pass by Jefferson Memorial along with the Tidal Basin and will visit **Lincoln memorial** where a large seated statue of Abraham Lincoln inside and two well-known speeches by him shown on the wall. The Vietnam War and the Korean War Veterans Memorial are located nearby the Lincoln Memorial, in which commemorates the sacrifices of American who served in both wars.

If time permits, we will also go to the **Madame Tussauds** in Washington D.C., which is the only place you can “really” get close to the “45 Presidents” during America’s history. Take the chance to explore the inner structure of The White House and to have photos with Oval Office’s Resolute Desk.

Then, we will head to Philadelphia to visit Liberty Bell and **National Independence Historical Park**. After finishing the entire itinerary today, our tour will return to New York.

Day 5 NEW YORK CITY TOUR- HOMETOWN

Our professional tour guide will take you to the NYC landmark - the Empire State building, it's an American cultural icon, by stepping up to the Empire State building, guests could overlook the beautiful view of the central park and the entire New York City. Nowadays, it is still the most famed landmark of the city of New York. Later on, guests will have a chance to take a sightseeing cruise on Hudson River to enjoy the city from a total different view, as well as take pictures with the backdrops of the statue of Liberty and Brooklyn Bridge. In addition, the U.S.S. Intrepid which was invested with 120 million dollars reopens for visitors, and now it has become a famous air and space museum. Concorde supersonic airliner and a variety of aircrafts will be all in the exhibition for the guests to visit. Take a walk on Wall Street; it's known as the world's financial center, taking pictures with the symbol of New York Stock Exchange-Charging Bull, and visiting Trinity Church. Of course, we will also pass by other famous landmarks such as Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller center, United Nation headquarters, World Trade Center and so on. If time allows, we will add-on option of Time Square, the Madame Tussaud Wax Museum and the museum of Modern Art to our itinerary
