Day1: Hometown – NYC (Self-guided tour in Flushing)

The first day itinerary is for your reference only; the schedule is subject to change upon your arrival.

Thanks for choosing your vacation with us! You can choose any one of the major airports in New York City (JFK, LGA, EWR) when you book your flight. Our professional tour guide will meet you at the baggage claim area for the domestic flight; for international flight, please arrive at the Passenger Waiting Area for pick up. (Passengers, who arrive at Terminal 7 of JFK Airport, please wait outside of the baggage claim area.)

1. Guests who arrive at JFK or LGA airport before 5:00pm will be sent to Flushing Queens. We will provide free luggage storage service, and our guests can visit nearby Queens Crossing, Macy's Shopping Center. In addition, Flushing is a safe and booming Asian commercial and retail area with many shopping and dining options. You will experience the distinctive Asian-American culture.
2. For those who arrive at EWR airport, feel free to take our shuttle to Jersey Garden Outlet and we will take you back to the hotel as soon as the rooms are ready to check-in.

New York Morning Tour

- For guests who meet tour guide before 9:00AM in JFK or LGA airport, guests can join morning tour.

- **Itinerary: DUMBO (20 mins) → Madison Square & Flatiron Building (Outside view, 20 mins) → Washington Square & New York University (Outside view, 15 mins)**

DUMBO is a neighborhood in the New York City borough of Brooklyn. On December 18, 2007, the New York City Landmarks Preservation Commission voted unanimously to designate Dumbo as the city's 90th historic district.

The Flatiron building has been called "one of the world's most iconic skyscrapers and a quintessential symbol of New York City", anchors the south (downtown) end of Madison Square and the north (uptown) end of the Ladies' Mile Historic District. The neighborhood around it is called the Flatiron District after its signature building, which has become an icon of New York City.

Washington Square Park is an open space, dominated by the Washington Square Arch at the northern gateway to the park, with a tradition of celebrating nonconformity. The park's fountain area has long been one of the city's popular spots for residents and tourists. Most of the buildings surrounding the park now belong to New York University.

- **Itinerary: Rockefeller Center (15 mins) → Times Square (30 mins) → An observation point in NJ (15 mins)**

Rockefeller Center is described as one of the greatest projects of the Great Depression era, Rockefeller Center was declared a New York City landmark in 1985 and a National Historic Landmark in 1987.

Times Square is a major commercial intersection, tourist destination, entertainment center and neighborhood. One of the world's busiest pedestrian areas. And it's very charming at night.

Great observation point in NJ, high up on the cliffs overlooking the Hudson River. There, you will enjoy what is considered to be the best night view of the New York City skyline.

Day 2 New York City Tour

We will enjoy our breakfast before we depart from the hotel. We will go for Wall Street financial district(40mins), taking photos with the Trinity Church, the Federal Hall, New York Stock Exchange, Charging Bull. Next we will head to the Empire State Building (60mins), which stood as the world's tallest skyscraper for nearly 40 years. The observation of Empire State gives a panoramic view of New York City. Moreover, we will take the Statue of Liberty Sightseeing Cruise (60mins), seeing the symbol of US "Liberty" while enjoying the view of Hudson River. We will also visit the "Crossroads of the world" Time Square (30mins) to experience the heart of world's entertainment industry. Of course, we will not miss the opportunity to visit the Metropolitan Museum of Art (120mins). Thousands of the collections will make your trip worth going. The last but not the least, we will go inside of United Nations Headquarters (30mins), the "International territory" in the world. (Guests must have valid passport or ID to enter)

Hotel: Doubletree (Princeton Area) or equivalent

Day 3 Philadelphia-Washington DC-Night Tour

We will enjoy our breakfast before we depart from the hotel. We will head to Philadelphia. Following the pursuit of independence, walking through the Independence Park; see the Independence Hall and Liberty Bell (40mins). Next we will go to the One Liberty Observation Deck (50mins), standing on the top of Philly and enjoy the stunning view of the first capital of US. Moreover, Rocky Steps (10mins) is popular and unique in Philly. We will stop at Reading Terminal Market for lunch(40mins). You may enjoy a Philly Cheesesteak! Then we will head to Washington D.C., taking the National Ferry Cruise (60mins) on Potomac River. Enjoy the view of the Pentagon, Air Force Memorial, Fort McNair Officers Club and Titanic Memorial etc. We will also visit the White House (20mins), Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial and Vietnam War Memorial (45mins). After dinner, we will start the night tour of Washington DC (60mins). We will come to the reflecting pool by the Capitol Hill, then Thomas Jefferson's Memorial, next World War II Memorial that can overlook Lincoln Memorial and Washington Monument.

Hotel: Springhill Suites by Marriott (Columbia, Maryland Area) or equivalent

Day 4 Washington DC

We will enjoy our breakfast before we depart from the hotel. First thing in the morning our tour leader will take you to the Tour of Capitol (90mins)—the temple of liberty. Then we will go inside of Library of Congress (20mins). (If the capitol and Library are closed, we will see the exterior of both) We will also see the Supreme Court of US (15mins) and that would be all three bureau of separation of powers in USA. For lunch, we will go to Shake Shack to enjoy one of the best burgers in town (Not included in tour fee). Shake Shack is an American fast casual restaurant chain based in New York City. It started out as a food cart inside Madison Square Park in 2004, and its popularity steadily grew. Now it has the best burger and fries in town(30mins). After lunch, we will go for the Madame Tussauds President Wax Museum (50mins), the only museum has all 44 "Presidents" of United States. Next we will go to the Ford's Theater (Exterior, 10mins) which is famous of President Lincoln's assassination. In the afternoon, we will leave the time for Smithsonian Museums (90mins). You may choose to visit National Air&Space Museum, National Gallery of Art, Museum of Natural History, and Museum of American History.

Hotel: Genetti Hotel & Suite (Williamsport Area) or equivalent

Day 5 Niagara Falls

We will enjoy our breakfast before we depart from the hotel. Arrive Niagara Falls around noon; we will start with Niagara Scenic Tour to Old Fort Niagara (50mins) and Whirlpool State Park (20mins) to enjoy the view of midstream and downstream of Niagara River. We will also go for the Niagara Adventure Ride of Jetboat (50mins), so-called "the Ferrari on the water". Then we will go for the Maid of Mist Boat

Tour (20mins) to see the Niagara Falls. (Horseshoe Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, American Falls) We will enjoy the IMAX movie (30mins) of Niagara Falls as well. After sunset, our tour leader will take you to the Goat Island. We will enjoy the night view of the falls. (Our tour leader will arrange the best time to see the night view according to the actual sunset time)

Hotel: Salvatore's Garden Place Hotel (Buffalo Airport Area) or equivalent

Day 6 Harvard University-Boston

We will enjoy our breakfast before we depart from the hotel. We will drive towards Boston along with the Erie Canal and I-90 East. The Harvard University (60mins) will be the first stop. Moreover, we will go to Christian Science Church - The Mother Church, The First Church of Christ (20mins) and Copley Square (20mins). Taking photos with Trinity Church of Boston and John Hancock Tower. Dinner will be taken place in Chinatown for Lobster Meal.

Day 7 Boston-Home

We will enjoy our breakfast before we depart from the hotel. We will start the day with “The Freedom Trail of Boston” walking tour (60mins). To be one of the “witnesses” of “Independence history”, we will walk through Boston Common, Park Street Church, Granary Burying Ground, Massachusetts State House, Old State House, Site of Boston Massacre, Faneuil Hall and so much more. If you prefer less walking sightseeing in Boston, you may choose to go for Boston Harbor Cruise (60mins). Next we will go to Quincy Market (50mins) to enjoy your various lunch choices. (We will separate the groups to different drop-off locations by the end of the tour)
