Itinerary

Day 1 Chicago – Detroit (12/27 Thursday) Hotel: Quality Inn & Suites North Youngstown or equivalent

In the morning, we are heading to the capital of automobiles, Detroit. We will stop at the headquarters of the General Motors Company and take pictures. Besides, we can take photos of the White House and the U.S. Capitol from outside due to the limitation of visit time for the public. Furthermore, you surely don't want to miss the opportunity to take a cruise for sightseeing of the town on the Potomac River! Along the way, you will see and pass by the Washington Monument, the World War II Memorial, the Thomas Jefferson Memorial, etc.

Day 4

New York City (12/30 Sunday)

During that time, roads around the countdown zone will be closed for pedestrian only; you can freely enjoy the bright lights of Times Square and experience the world-famous New Year Eve's celebrations.
