### **Day 1 Home – Miami**

The first day itinerary is for your reference only; the schedule is subject to change upon your arrival. Thanks for choosing your vacation with us! Guests will meet our tour guide at the baggage claim area at MIA/FLL, Miami ferry port (POM), or Fort Lauderdale ferry port (POE) and are able to take the free scheduled shuttle bus to hotel. (Complimentary pick-up service is available between 10 AM and 10 PM for MIA/FLL; at 9:00AM or 12:00PM for POM and 10:30AM for POE) Enjoy some free time for the rest of your day or enjoy shopping at either Aventura Mall or Dolphin Mall (shopping time between 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM, transportation fee \$20/person/one way). The Aventura Mall is an upscale super-regional shopping mall in Aventura, Florida, which has Nordstrom, Bloomingdale's, Macy's, and JC Penney with 280 top brands...; Dolphin Mall brings together over 240 fashion-forward and family-friendly retailers in a value oriented setting, making it the ultimate shopping destination in Miami. By the night, guests can sign up for an optional night tour at South Beach, where known as an oceanfront playground offering non-stop nightlife with the pulsating worlds of music, iconic bars and swaying palms. (Night tour is available with at least 2 enrolled guests of arrival before 6PM. \$35/person)

### **Day 2 Miami Everglades National Park – Miami**

Guests will arrive at the biggest conservation zone in USA, the Everglades National Park where you can take an everglades airboat to explore natural wonders and watch rare animals show. Guests will also get a chance to watch how to catch alligators on site. Next, you can appreciate the “City Beautiful”, Coral Gables, where described as an “International Residential Museum”. It stands out for its planned community that blends the wide tree-lined avenues, exotic mansions in Mediterranean Revival architectural style and historical landmarks such as the world-famous Biltmore Hotel and the Venetian Pool, both built in the 1920s. The picturesque Biltmore Hotel is backdrop of a renowned 18-hole golf course. Furthermore, Little Havana, the famous Cuban area attracts large groups of tourists from all over the world. You can visit Cuban cigar workshops and take a sip of Cuban coffee. In addition, tourists can take a cruise sightseeing around the Biscayne Bay which set off from the Bayside Marketplace. This cruise takes you by the homes of some of the world's "rich and famous" (called Millionaire's Row), along the stunning Miami Skyline as well as overlooking the America's second largest financial hub of the downtown Miami and more. Tourists will be impressed by the famous sea south beach with white sand, the clear blue water, and gorgeous scenery. Yet there's more - the art DECO street known as the No.1 district of Deco architecture with colorful buildings and a villa formerly owned by the well-known Italian fashion designer Versace.

### **Day 3 Key West**

It is 170 miles from Miami to Key West through 32 islands and 42 bridges. It is also known as “Duck Island” because of its shape, and also the international Key West Film Festival was held

here every year! World famous Seven-Mile Bridge is another highlighted attraction here. It takes eight years to complete and is quite famous for the magnificent scenery. The former California governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's movie "True Lies" was also filmed in Key West. The amazing scenery along the south nation and colorful beaches will make you feel in a fairy land. Here guests can take pictures with its landmark "the edge of the sky, the rim of the sea". The next famous stop is the home of the former residence---Nobel Prize winners Hemingway. After that, tourists can buy some souvenirs in local stores. On the way back to hotel, guests will have a chance to see the fabulous sunset.

#### **Day 4 Lion Country Safari – West Palm Beach – Sawgrass Mills Mall**

We will travel to Lion Country Safari, West Palm Beach, Palm Beach and Fort Lauderdale today. The first destination will be Lion Country Safari. Guests will have chance to experience the real wild life here. This park is also claimed to be the first 'cageless zoo' in the United States. After, we will go to West Palm Beach. West Palm Beach is 70 miles distance from the north of Miami connected to the Palm Beach by cross-sea Bridge. Palm Beach is viewed as America's "Riviera" which has 47 miles long coastline and hundreds of high-class restaurants, see-view mansions, and luxury hotels...In addition, we will also see the Henry Morrison Flagler Museum from outside, which is known as Whitehall with 55-room in Palm Beach. When it was established in 1902, the New York Herald proclaimed that Whitehall, Henry Flagler's Gilded Age estate in Palm Beach, was "more wonderful than any palace in Europe, grander and more magnificent than any other private dwelling in the world". Spend time at the Worth Avenue in Palm Beach, an upscale shopping district which was ranked as the one of the top 3 "Most Iconic" streets in America at 2013. By afternoon, we will head to the second largest shopping mall in Florida -- Sawgrass Mills Mall.

#### **Day 5 Fort Lauderdale – Seattle**

In the morning, guests will go to the north of Miami - Fort Lauderdale "the city of boat in the world". Then view the Venice of America's ever-changing panorama of lush tropical foliage. There are homes of millions and luxury yachts now or formerly owned by Microsoft billionaires Paul Allen, Hollywood mogul Steven Spielberg, hot dog impresario Oscar Mayer, and H. Wayne Huizenga, the founder of Waste Management, AutoNation, Blockbuster Video, and onetime owner of the Marlins, The Dolphins, and the Florida Panthers. We will play at the Fort Lauderdale Beach, one of the top ten beaches in America. Next, we will head to Bloomingdale's. Here guests will receive a 10% off voucher and exclusive selling activity. Once the purchase amount reach to \$6600(without tax), you will be awarded with an iPad Air. (Note: Each guest every time is able to get two iPad Airs at maximum, while supplies last. If the iPad Air is not available, there will offer another equal price Apple production). Afternoon, we will drop off guests at FLL airport first and then at MIA airport, taking national flight and flying to Seattle.

**Please book the flight departure from Fort Lauderdale airport (FLL) or from Miami airport (MIA) after 2:00PM. Complimentary pick-up service is available at SEA airport from 9:00AM-10:00PM. Guests who arrive on other time may go to the hotel by themselves, or pay for the airport transport service. 24-hour paid transportation service is available for the first two persons at \$120 and with \$10 for each additional person.**

### **Day 6 Seattle City Tour**

Seattle is the largest city in both the State of Washington and Pacific Northwest region of North America. Here, we will bring you to take a tour inside Boeing factory located in WA. Being the largest aircraft manufacturer in the world, at its factory you will learn the history of aircraft making as well as see one of the four huge Dreamlifters in the world; there will be professional Boeing employee guiding you to tour the Boeing Assembly Plant inside the world's largest building (by volume) to watch Boeing 747, 777 and 787 Dreamliner jets being assembled. Boeing can build a miracle in only 3 days, so get ready to widen your eyes with an unparalleled experience. Next, we will go to Pike Place Market which opened over a hundred years ago and is one of the oldest continuously operated public farmers' markets in the United States. Originated by farmers for selling their products, the Pike Place Market is now one of the major tour attractions in Seattle, holding about 200 commercial events every year and exhibiting 190 kinds of handcrafts by 120 agriculture vendors plus street performers. It is worth noting that the first and original Starbucks store opened here in 1971. After strolling around the market, we will head to Space Needle. Space Needle is an observation tower and an icon of Seattle. It was built in the Seattle Center for the 1962 World's Fair. On top of the tower you are offered with free telescope to see the amazing view of not only Seattle city but also Puget Sound and Mt. Rainier. Another surprise will be the "Teleporter" kiosks that were created and collaborated between the Space Needle and Microsoft. Using Microsoft Photosynth technology and content shot by Creature, the 520 Teleporter offers a 3D experience that can't be found anywhere else. Then we will visit the EMP museum located at the foot of Space Needle. EMP stands for Experience Music Project. EMP is the first commercial project that Frank O. Gehry, the avant-garde architect, has designed in the Pacific Northwest. Founded by Paul Allen the Microsoft cofounder, EMP Museum is dedicated to the ideas and risk-taking that fuel popular culture. Three thousand panels, made up of 21,000 individually cut and shaped stainless steel and painted aluminum shingles, encase the stunning outside of the building. In the end, we will complete the Seattle's tour by visiting the Pioneer Square. Pioneer Square is Seattle's Original neighborhood since 1852. Naturally, this historical community has experienced many changes over the course of time dating back to the Gold Rush, featuring the perfect balance of old coexisting with new.

### **Day 7 Olympic National Park**

Olympic National Park is a national park located in the Olympic Peninsula, WA. The park consists of four regions: the Pacific coastline, alpine areas, the west side temperate rainforest and the forests of the drier east side. With nearly one million acres, Olympic national park encompasses several distinctly different ecosystems and protects a rich mosaic of natural and cultural history. It protects 73 miles of wild Pacific coast. Tide pools, sandy beaches and rocky cliffs can all be found here. At the center of the peninsula are the majestic glacier capped Olympic Mountains. Hurricane Ridge, over a mile high, offers spectacular views of mountains, wildflowers, deer, black bear, and other wildlife. The 10-acre natural lake, Lake Crescent, located at an elevation of 600 feet is a pristine area that provides visitors with an extraordinary place for recreation and relaxation. Only a few places of interest allow the automobiles to enter the natural beauty. There is a wealth of outdoor activities with over 900 miles of trails traversing the vast

interior of the recognized wildness. When going back to Seattle, you can take the Bainbridge Island ferry to enjoy the breathtaking views of Seattle’s coastline.

**Day 8 Snoqualmie Falls – Leavenworth German Town**

See the Snoqualmie Falls, one of Washington State’s most popular scenic attractions visited by 1.5 million visitors every year. Explore Leavenworth the German village which is 2.5 hours’ drive northwest of Seattle, the most beloved town in this area where people celebrates all the time. You can see beautiful maple leaves in fall, and in winter, the town is adorned by white snow and holiday decorations. Lovely atmosphere can be found everywhere all year round. Enjoy shopping of delicate European souvenirs and taste the authentic German food and beer, or try on some traditional German costume clothes.

**Upon your tour completion, we will send you to the Seattle - Tacoma International Airport (SEA) only. Please book your flights departing after 7:00PM.**
