Itinerary

Day 1: New York, NY - New Haven, CT - Newport, RI - Cambridge, MA - Boston, MA

In the morning, tour starts from New York to New Haven, Connecticut, and stop at Yale University which was founded in 1701. Yale University is the nation's third oldest institution of higher education in the Ivy League. With the campus tour guide, you can stroll leisurely in the ancient campus and will have an amazing experience of the university atmosphere. After lunch, tour continues to Newport, Rhode Island. Through the famous Newport Bridge you will see the luxurious The Breakers mansion. Here, we can personally experience the glory of the American gold rush era of wealth. The 1895 mansion was patterned after a Renaissance palace. No matter the unique decoration of the building or the delicate artworks were all handcrafted in Europe then shipped to the location. The bus tour will head to the historic Cambridge City in Massachusetts and visit Harvard University, another member of the Ivy League, who enjoys the reputation, wealth and influence in the world, and is renowned as the U.S. government think tanks, often ranked first in the world universities. Here, you will amble in Harvard's oldest campus and take pictures with the statue of John Harvard, known as the "Statue of Three Lies". Next go to the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, which was established in 1861. We will

take pictures with the backdrop of MIT's modern main buildings. Arrive in Boston, you will have the opportunity to enjoy Boston's most famous feast – **Lobster.** On the way to dinner, tour bus will *pass by* Trinity Church and Massachusetts State House of the gold dome. Trinity Church is a characteristic example of major U.S. Christian faith and religious centers. The State House with the gold dome top, built in 1795-1797, is located on Beacon Hill, overlooking the Boston. *Standard Hotel: Red Roof Inn Woburn, Days Inn Middleboro or equivalent*

Day 2: Boston, MA - New York, NY

After breakfast, tour continues in Boston. Fun will begin as soon as you board the **Boston** Harbor Cruise and enjoy a view of the shoreline of Boston. Boston Harbor Cruises will show you such a fascinating city where witness the history, people, heritages, stories and many others as well as the famous sight of USS Constitution. The ship is one of six original frigates ordered for construction by the Naval Act of 1794 and named by George Washington after the Constitution launched in 1797. USS Constitution is the oldest commissioned warship afloat in the world. Next, visit the **New England Aquarium**, which opened in 1969, is a global leader in ocean exploration and marine conservation. The Aquarium is one of the premier visitor attractions in Boston, with over 1.3 million visitors a year, and a major public education resource. With four-story Giant Ocean Tank features a brand new coral reef, an underwater communications system, large windows and hundreds of Caribbean reef animals, including sea turtles, stingrays, eels and fish the exhibit goes down 26 feet, it is 40 feet wide and holds 200,000 gallons of salt water. (Mystic Aquarium will replace the New England Aquarium if there is some adjustment for the itinerary based on actual situation.) At lunch, we will visit **Quincy Market** (Faneuil Hall Marketplace). Bustling Quincy Market is probably the oldest bazaar in the United States. It is opportune for strolling through, or to get a taste of the historical ambience as well as to pick out souvenirs among the assorted merchants and artisans. At last, tour will return to New York at the evening.
