These large ice sculpture exhibition display in Gaylord National Resort and Convention Center, the Potomac River in Maryland. It attracts a large number of visitors come to watch the exhibition every year. The attract part of these ice sculptures is that these ice is come from Ohio ice-making plants, a total of 5000 pieces of ice and 1,500 LED lamps. These ice sculptures were spent forty days carved by the forty invited Harbin ice technicians. The organizers set up large tent in the open air, the temperature is maintained at about minus 12 degrees. The ice sculptures display in the large tent. To eliminate cold winter troubles, the organizers also provide visitors the cotton coat to keep them warm. So you do not

have to go to Quebec's views to admire the ice.

We will continue to share the message of peace with the National Christmas Tree in White House. The grand illumination of the Christmas lights on the tree by the President of the United States early in the Christmas season is an annual televised

Event and the start of month-long festivities known as the Pageant of Peace. Nearby smaller trees and other decorations leading up to the National Christmas Tree are referred to as the Pathway to Peace.
