# **Itinerary**

## **Day 1**

### **Secret Caverns – Niagara Falls (Night View)**

Hotel: **Quality Inn Buffalo Airport hotel or equivalent**

**Secret Caverns (Self-paid, 60 mins) → Niagara IMAX movie (self – paid, 45 mins) → Niagara Falls Night View**

### **Special Notes:**

1. Due to the cold weather and frozen road since November, Secret Caverns may be closed on some departure date
2. The completeness of night view on certain summer evenings may be limited or not available due to late sunset time and US Federal Government regulations on driving hours.

- **Secret Caverns**

A 103-step staircase with various layers of limestone deposited faithfully by the prehistoric ocean is the only way in or out. Many of the caverns in this area were formed largely during the last Ice Age about 38,000-14,000 years ago. "For thousands of years mineral laden water has been precipitating on the walls, ceiling, and floor of the caverns, leaving behind great deposits of golden calcite. When these deposits hang from the ceiling like icicles, they are called stalactites. When they build up from the floor, they are called stalagmites. And when you see calcite dripping down over the walls or covering the rocks, that is called flowstone." – You will have a wonderful time with all the views mentioned!

- **Niagara IMAX movie**

This movie, which guests will view on an impressive 45-foot-wide screen, tells the history of human interaction with the falls, focusing largely on the "daredevils" who have crossed, boated, and even jumped off them.

### **Niagara Falls In-Depth Tour**

This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder - [Niagara Whirlpool State Park](#) and the U.S. historic landmark - [Old Fort Niagara](#). The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It is estimated the whirlpool formed approximately 7,500 years ago by the upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by Niagara River. Old Fort Niagara is a rich historic landmark; it spans more than 300 years. Its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in the French and Indian War, the American Revolution and the War of 1812. The gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort.

### **Maid of the Mist**

It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful. More than 6 million cubic ft. (168,000 cubic meters) of water goes over the crest line of the falls every minute during peak daytime tourist hours. This famous Maid of the Mist ride gets passengers as close as possible to the Niagara Falls! The Maid rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls.

### **Niagara Jetboat**

These exciting boat rides take passengers on a thrilling trip down the Niagara River! This 45-minute round-trip ride zooms through the Niagara Gorge, and even takes passengers to the famous Whirlpool rapids, all of a custom-built jet boat.

### **Watkins Glen State Park**

Watkins Glen State Park - is the most famous of the Finger Lakes State Parks. Within two miles, the glen's stream descends 400 feet past 200-foot cliffs, generating 19 waterfalls along its course. The gorge path winds over and under waterfalls and through the spray of Cavern Cascade. Rim trails overlook the gorge. It's a perfect park for photography!

### **Corning Glass Museum**

In western New York is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. Its collection contains more than 45,000 objects, some of which date back millennia. Guests here will be invited to watch the Hot Glass Show which is performed by professional glass craftsman, and, will have chance to know how ancient Egyptian made the world first glass mask in 3000 years ago!

## **Day 3**

### **Washington D.C. – Philadelphia**

**National Air and Space Museum** (60mins) → **the DC Sightseeing cruise** (Self - paid, 60mins) / **International Spy Museum** (Self - paid, after DC Sightseeing cruise closed, 75mins) → **Capitol Hill** (Outside Visit) → **The White House** (外觀) → **Lincoln memorial** (45mins) → **Madame Tussands Washington, D.C.** (Self - paid, If time permits, 60mins) → **National Independence Historical Park.**

#### **Special Notes:**

1. When the DC cruise closed during winter, we will visit International Spy Museum instead.

- **National Air and Space Museum.** It records the history of the space industry: from the Wright Brothers' aircrafts in 1903 to modern out space exploration, St. Louis's Lindbergh's Spirit to the real Apollo 11 cockpit. It has the most sufficient documents of aerospace history all over the world.
- **the DC cruises**  
The Potomac River runs along Washington, DC, the capital city of the United States of America. Visitors to this famous locale can opt to see many of the area's most historic landmarks and memorials in a unique way.
- **International Spy Museum**  
The museum is a museum exploring the craft, practice, history, and contemporary role of espionage. It is the only public museum in the United States solely dedicated to espionage and the only one in the world to provide a global perspective on an all-but-invisible profession.).
- **United States Capitol**

The famous United States Capitol is the meeting place of the US Congress and has been for more than 200 years. The building is famous for its elaborate dome and intricately designed, detailed columns.

- **The White House**

The world-famous White House in Washington, DC is the official residence of the president of the United States and the place where most of the work is done. The facade of this neoclassical mansion is a global icon.

- **Lincoln memorial**

where a large seated statue of Abraham Lincoln inside and two well-known speeches by him shown on the wall. The Vietnam War and the Korean War Veterans Memorial are located nearby the Lincoln Memorial, in which commemorates the sacrifices of American who served in both wars.

- **Madame Tussands Washington, D.C.**

in Washington D.C., which is the only place you can “really” get close to the “45 Presidents” during America’s history. Take the chance to explore the inner structure of The White House and to have photos with Oval Office’s Resolute Desk.

- **National Independence Historical Park.**

This National Historical Park in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania serves as a way of preserving important Revolutionary War sites for future generations. Called "America's most historic square mile," this 55-acre park in the "Old City" district is not to be missed.
