#### **Itinerary**

#### Day 1: New York-Chesapeake Bay Bridge-Virginia Beach

Departure from New York City in the morning, our tour begins by traveling through the beautiful scenery from the state of New York down to North Carolina.

First, arrive at **Chesapeake Bay Bridge**, known as one of the Seven Engineering Wonders of the Modern World. It is a 23-mile (37 km) long fixed link crossing the mouth of the Chesapeake Bay and connecting the Delmarva Peninsula's Eastern Shore of Virginia with Virginia Beach and the metropolitan area of Hampton Roads, Virginia. Afterward, we will stop at the **Virginia Beach**. Festival fish, jumping dolphins, frolicking porpoise...all in bright, colored lights at the beach mark the official start of the holiday season along Virginia Beach. This unique light show has drawn more 25.000 families to visit each year, and it has been named one of the Southeast Tourism Society's "Top 20 November Events." Then we will reach North Carolina for night.

#### Day 2: South of the Borders (Carolina)-Georgia-Orlando, Florida

Continuing our tour down to the South on day 2, we will pass through South of the

Border and Savannah, Georgia. **South of the Border** is a rest stop and roadside attraction between Dillon, South Carolina and Rowland, North Carolina. Its Mexican themed kitsch location has served as a rest stop for tourist traveling to and from Florida since 1950s. Its mascot is Pedro, an extravagantly stereotypical Mexican bandito.

**Savannah** is the oldest city in the State of Georgia. Its' unique architecture and historic buildings have attracted millions of visitors. Its' beautiful scenery also can be seen from the movie "Forest Gum". Its' favorite stories also involve the life of Florence Martus, who was known by Savannahinas and sailors of the sea as "the Waving Girl". Florence Martus took it upon herself to be the unofficial greeter of all ships that entered and left the Port of Savannah. At night we will arrive in Orlando, Florida.

Enjoy sightseeing in **Miami** with its scenery beauty later the day. You will discover the beautiful side of the fashionable and exciting international hot spot, Miami. Art Deco District, Little Havana and Downtown are some of the best highlights of Miami. You will then journey aboard a narrated sightseeing cruise along Biscayne Bay where you will see downtown Miami, the Port of Miami, Fisher Island and the homes of the rich and famous known as "Millionaire's Row".

This hard packed sand made Daytona Beach a mecca for motorsports, with the old Daytona Beach Road Course having hosted races for over 50 years. This course was replaced in 1959 by the Daytona International Speedway. The city is also the headquarters for NASCAR and the Grand American Road Racing Association.

**St. Augustine**, founded in 1565 by Spanish explorer and admiral Pedro Menéndez de Avilés, it is the oldest continuously occupied European-established city and port in the continental United States. St. Augustine lies in a region of Florida known as "The First Coast", which extends from Amelia Island in the north to Jacksonville, St. Augustine, and Palm Coast in the south.
