Day 1: New York - Virginia Busch Gardens Christmas Town

Day 2: Hotel- South of the Border (Carolina)-Savannah, Georgia

South of the Border is a rest stop and roadside attraction between Dillon, South Carolina and Rowland, North Carolina. Its Mexican themed kitsch location has served as a rest stop for tourist traveling to and from Florida since 1950s. Its mascot is Pedro, an extravagantly stereotypical Mexican bandito.

Savannah is the oldest city in the State of Georgia. Its' unique architecture and historic buildings have attracted millions of visitors. Its' beautiful scenery also can be seen from the movie "Forest Gum". Its' favorite stories involve the life of Florence Martus, who was known by Savannahinas and sailors of the sea as "the Waving Girl". Florence Martus took it upon herself to be the unofficial greeter of all ships that entered and left the Port of Savannah.

Day 3: Orland EYE - Gatorland - Downtown Orlando

This course was replaced in 1959 by the Daytona International Speedway. The city is also the headquarters for NASCAR and the Grand American Road Racing Association.

St. Augustine, founded in 1565 by Spanish explorer and admiral Pedro Menéndez de Avilés, it is the oldest continuously occupied European-established city and port in the continental United States. St. Augustine lies in a region of Florida known as "The First Coast", which extends from Amelia Island in the north to Jacksonville, St. Augustine, and Palm Coast in the south.
