1) Brooklyn – 8th Ave location is only available for pick-up, no drop-off. The drop-off location will be Chinatown – Manhattan at Bowery Street.

**2) East Brunswick, NJ 7:00AM pickup and drop off arrangement during May 25<sup>th</sup> –Sept 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017):**

**Pick up:** Shuttle bus will pick up the East Brunswick 7:00am departure passengers and send to Jersey City-Acme Market.



**Drop-off arrangement:** in order to effectively arrange the East Brunswick drop off during 5/25-9/3/2017, ALL East Brunswick drop-off passengers will be send to Manhattan- Chinatown (87 Bowery, New York) first, And then Transfer to the shuttle bus back to East Brunswick.

The time for our shuttle departure from Chinatown to East Brunswick will be depending on all the tour buses have come back to the meeting point. Since the returning times for different tours vary, passengers who need to go back to East Brunswick have to patiently wait for our shuttle in the meeting point.

**Itinerary Highlights:** Watkins Glen (summer)/Corning (winter), Maid of the Mist, Niagara Falls In-depth Tour

## **Day 1: New York - Watkins Glen (summer)/Corning (winter) - Niagara Falls**

We will head north to **Watkins Glen State Park** in the Finger Lakes region of New York. In the winter, Watkins Glen State Park will be substituted by **Corning Glass Museum** to learn of glassmaking. From there we will continue on to **Niagara Falls, NY** where we will see **Native American Dance Show** and **Niagara Falls Illumination**.

### **\*Watkins Glen State Park (Summer Schedule: Mid of May – October)**

**Watkins Glen State Park** - is the most famous of the Finger Lakes State Parks. Within two miles, the glen's stream descends 400 feet past 200-foot cliffs, generating 19 waterfalls along its course. The gorge path winds over and under waterfalls and through the spray of Cavern Cascade. Rim trails overlook the gorge. It's a perfect park for photography! (**Note: we charge \$10/person for state park admission and bus parking.**) (\*\*We will visit Watkins Glenn only when weather condition allows. In case of rainy weather, we reserve the right to change the itinerary to Corning Glass considering safety issues.)

### **\*Corning, NY (Winter Schedule: November – May)**

**Corning Glass Museum** - in western New York is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. Its collection contains more than 45,000 objects, some of which date back millennia. Guests here will be invited to watch the Hot Glass Show which is performed by professional glass craftsman, and also, will have chance to know how did ancient Egyptian make the world first glass mask in 3000 years ago!

### **\*Niagara Fall**

**Niagara Falls Illumination** - For more than 75 years, visitors to Niagara Falls have been able to enjoy a nighttime illumination of the impressive American and Horseshoe falls. Every night of the year at dusk, visitors can experience the falls a new way. (\*The completeness of night view on certain summer evenings may be limited or not available due to late sunset time and US Federal Government regulations on driving hours.)

**Native American Dance Show**, like many impressive wonders of nature, is a sacred place for the local Native American people. This show uses dance as a storytelling medium through which to showcase the impact that the falls have had on native culture.

## **Day 2: Niagara Falls In-depth Tour - Maid of the Mist (summer) - New York**

Departure from the hotel in the morning, we will continue to explore Niagara Falls, NY where we will take **Niagara Falls In-depth Tour** and take the famous **Maid of the Mist** boat ride (closed in winter and will be replaced by **Jet Boat**). Afterwards, we will go back to the pick-up points in New York in the evening.

**\*Niagara Falls In-Depth Tour** - This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder - **Niagara Whirlpool State Park** and the U.S. historic landmark - **Old Fort Niagara**. The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It is estimated the whirlpool formed approximately 4,200 years ago by the upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by Niagara River. Old Fort Niagara is a rich historic landmark; it spans more than 300 years. Its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in the French and Indian War, the American Revolution and the War of 1812. The gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort.

**\*(Summer Schedule: April-Oct, 2016) Maid of the Mist** - It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful. More than 6 million cubic ft. (168,000 cubic meters) of water goes over the crest line of the falls every minute during peak daytime tourist hours. This famous Maid of the Mist ride gets passengers as close as possible to the Niagara Falls! The Maid rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls.

**\*\*\* MAID OF THE MIST is only available between April to October.** (Operation schedule is subject to change every year according to weather and river conditions.) During November to May of next year, you can optionally watch a **Niagara IMAX movie**, which chronicles more than 12,000 years of history and examines human interaction with the falls from ancient time through the people - like you - who come to see them today.

**\*(Winter Schedule) Jet Boat** - If you want your trip more memorable and refreshing, you definitely won't want to miss the excitement of playing in the whitewater rapids by JETBOAT on the Niagara River. Whirlpool Jet Boat Tours operates a fleet of custom-built vessels designed to the latest innovations in marine technology. The boats use a triple turbo diesel water jet system for propulsion and steering, a design that creates incredible reliability and safety in the turbulent whitewater rapids. **(\*\*JetBoat tour is available only when weather conditions allow; in case of storm, snow, icy condition of the Niagara River, the boat tour will be closed for safety reasons.)**

### **Scenic Spots Notes:**

- (1) Itinerary will be subject to traffic and weather. The sequence of the attractions might be changed according to actual and practical situation for better service.
- (2) In case of attraction closures (due to holidays or construction, etc.), tour guide may make some necessary changes to the itinerary accordingly.



(3) This tour does not accept any City Pass or your own tickets for the attraction. Guests need to purchase admission tickets from tour leader.
