**Itinerary highlight: Corning Museum of Glass/Watkins Glen, Maid of the Mist, Niagara Scenic Tour

Itinerary

Day One: In the morning. We will head to Niagara Falls to ride the Maid of the Mist. This famous boat ride gets passengers up close and personal with the Niagara Falls! The Maid rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls. At the evening, will see the Niagara Fall night view. For more than 75 years, visitors to Niagara Falls have been able to enjoy a nighttime illumination of the impressive American and Horseshoe falls. Every night of the year at dusk, visitors can experience the falls a new way. (*The completeness of night view on certain summer evenings may be limited or not available due to late sunset time and US Federal Government regulations on driving hours.)

Day Two: In the morning, we will also have the option of joining an In-Depth Tour of the area that visits places such as Whirlpool State Park and Old Fort Niagara.
