Itinerary

Day 1 Home – Miami

The first day itinerary is for your reference only; the schedule is subject to change upon your arrival. Thanks for choosing your vacation with us! Guests will meet our tour guide at the baggage claim area at MIA/FLL, Miami ferry port (POM), or Fort Lauderdale ferry port (POE) and are able to take the free scheduled shuttle bus to hotel. (Complimentary pick-up service is available between 10 AM and 10 PM for MIA/FLL; at 9:00AM or 12:00PM for POM and 10:30AM for POE) Enjoy some free time for the rest of your day or enjoy shopping at either Aventura Mall or Dolphin Mall (shopping time between 12 pm to 5 pm, transportation fee \$20/person/one way). The Aventura Mall is an upscale super-regional shopping mall in Aventura, Florida, which has Nordstrom, Bloomingdale's, Macy's, and JC Penney with 280 top brands...; Dolphin Mall brings together over 240 fashion-forward and family-friendly retailers in a value oriented setting, making it the ultimate shopping destination in Miami.

By the night, guests can sign up for an optional night tour at South Beach, where known as an oceanfront playground offering non-stop nightlife with the pulsating worlds of music, iconic bars and swaying palms. (Night tour is available with at least 2 enrolled guests of arrival before 6PM. \$35/person)

Day 2 Key West

It is 170 miles from Miami to Key West through 32 islands and 42 bridges. It is also known as “Duck Island” because of its shape, and also the international Key West Film Festival was held here every year! World famous Seven-Mile Bridge is another highlighted attraction here. It takes eight years to complete and is quite famous for the magnificent scenery. The former California governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's movie “True Lies” was also filmed in Key West. The amazing scenery along the south nation and colorful beaches will make you feel in a fairy land. Here guests can take pictures with its landmark “the edge of the sky, the rim of the sea”. The next famous stop is the home of the former residence---Nobel Prize winners Hemingway. After that, tourists can buy some souvenirs in local stores. On the way back to hotel, guests will have a chance to see the fabulous sunset.

Day 3 Miami Everglades Safari Park – Miami

Guests will arrive at the biggest conservation zone in USA, Everglades, the swamp national park where you can take an airboat ride known as “fly on the grass” to explore natural wonders and watch rare animals show. Guests will also get a chance to watch how to catch alligators on site. Next, you can appreciate the “City Beautiful”, Coral Gables, where described as an “International Residential Museum”. It stands out for its planned community that blends the wide tree-lined avenues, exotic mansions in Mediterranean Revival architectural style and historical landmarks such as the world-famous Biltmore Hotel and the Venetian Pool, both built in the 1920s. The picturesque Biltmore Hotel is backdrop of a renowned 18-hole golf course. Furthermore, Little Havana, the famous Cuban area attracts large groups of tourists from all over the world. You can visit Cuban cigar workshops and take a sip of Cuban coffee. In addition, tourists can take a cruise sightseeing around the Biscayne Bay which set off from the Bayside

Marketplace. This cruise takes you by the homes of some of the world's "rich and famous" (called Millionaire's Row), along the stunning Miami Skyline as well as overlooking the America's second largest financial hub of the downtown Miami and more. Tourists will be impressed by the famous sea south beach with white sand, the clear blue water, and gorgeous scenery. Yet there's more - the art deco street known as the No.1 district of Deco architecture with colorful buildings and a villa formerly owned by the well-known Italian fashion designer Versace.

Day 4 Fort Lauderdale – Chicago (airfare not included)

In the morning, guests will view the Venice of America's ever-changing panorama of lush tropical foliage. There are homes of millions and luxury yachts now or formerly owned by Microsoft billionaires Paul Allen, Hollywood mogul Steven Spielberg, hot dog impresario Oscar Mayer, and H. Wayne Huizenga, the founder of Waste Management, AutoNation, Blockbuster Video, and onetime owner of the Marlins, The Dolphins, and the Florida Panthers. Next, we will head to Bloomingdale's. Here guests will receive a 10% off voucher and exclusive selling activity. Once the purchase amount reach to \$6600(without tax), you will be awarded with an iPad Air. (Note: Each guest every time is able to get two iPad Airs at maximum, while supplies last. If the iPad Air is not available, there will offer another equal price Apple production). Guests will be taken to the FLL firstly, then MIA in the afternoon to leave for Chicago. For passengers arriving with domestic flights, please wait at Waiting-area of Baggage Claim, Tour guide will lead you to the meeting point.

Please book the flight departure from Fort Lauderdale airport (FLL) or from Miami airport (MIA) after 2:00PM. (Complimentary pick-up service is available at ORD airport between 9:00AM-9:00PM. Guests who arrive on other time or flight to MDW airport may go to the hotel by themselves, or pay for the airport transport service. 24-hour paid transportation service is available for the first two persons at \$120 and with \$10 for each additional person.

Day 5 Chicago City Tour

This tour will show you the best of Chicago in one day. This is the world's top architecture city with bold architectures. You will take a walk in the Millennium Park, a combination of stunning architecture, sculpture and landscape design located in the heart of downtown Chicago; you will see Cloud Gate, the impressive signature urban sculpture and one of the best public spaces that you can find on earth. Take a break at the Clarence Buckingham Memorial Fountain, one of the world's largest artificial fountains. Stroll around the Navy Pier, the former Navy training center, which is the most visited lakeshore park in central United States now. You will also take an exclusive tour of the Chicago Theatre, an exquisite French Baroque style theatre. Another stop is Michigan Avenue, the Magnificent Mile, where the Art Institute of Chicago, Grant Park, the historical Chicago Water Tower, shopping malls and boutique stores are located. To have the best view of this famous city, you will go up to the 360 CHICAGO which soars 1,000 feet above Lake Michigan and the city's majestic skyline to offer the most breathtaking views of downtown Chicago, the lakefront and four neighboring states: Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Wisconsin. It newly presents an enclosed, glass and steel moveable platform that tilts outward 304 meter above the Magnificent Mile and safely holds up to eight visitors at a time, which will be another thrilling experience for whom like to challenge themselves. As the birthplace of skyscrapers, Chicago has a skyline bristling with skyscrapers. Chicago River flows backwards from Lake Michigan

and is lined up with best architecture in town: the corn-cob shaped Marina City buildings, Trump Tower, Willis Tower and etc. Take our river cruise to enjoy the stunning urban view of Chicago.

Day 6 Nearby Attractions of Chicago – Home

There is a lot of fun to be discovered around Chicago as well. Our tour will start with the biggest industrial city of Wisconsin--Milwaukee, birthplace of Harley-Davidson motorcycles; Visit Harley-Davidson Museum and learn the history of the legendary motorcycle brand from the 450 motorcycle collections including the oldest and well-known Harley-Davidson motorcycle. In addition, we will pass by The Harris Bradley Center, home court of NBA Milwaukee Bucks and the St. Joseph's Catholic Church. After the lunch, guests will be taken to the Northwestern University. It is one of the best universities in United States which has more than 150 years of history, ranking the 14th among American universities, 30th among universities in the world. We will then visit the Bahá'í House of Worship in Wilmette, Illinois. It is the oldest surviving Bahá'í House of Worship in the world, and the only one in the United States. The Bahá'í Faith is a monotheistic religion emphasizing the spiritual unity of different humankind. It now has five million followers in virtually every nation on earth and is the second-most widespread faith. By the evening, we will head to the airport.
