Here, guests can overlook the deafening roar of the American Falls, the Horseshoe Falls and the Bridal Veil Falls! [If time allows, guests will have chance to take the impressive and exciting Niagara Jet Boat – an exclusive ride on the Niagara River which makes the tour unforgettable and refreshing by playing in the whitewater rapids. \(*Jet Boat tour will be closed under tough weather or river icy condition.\)](#) Get soaked with the mist when you are strolling in the State Park. Absolutely, you will like the "Niagara: Legends of Adventure", a dramatic 45-minute IMAX film on the new screen (45 feet × 25 feet), to discover the history and culture of the Niagara Falls [\(If time's not allowed, customers would see the movie at Canada side\)](#). Afterwards, you can choose either: A. to self-explore the Falls Park until returning to the hotel. B. to take Niagara Falls In-depth Tour [\(Tour fee: \\$25/person, including \\$13 of the admission ticket\)](#). This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder - Niagara Whirlpool State Park and the U.S. historic landmark - Old Fort Niagara. The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It has estimated the whirlpool formed approximately 4,200 years ago by the upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by Niagara River. Old Fort Niagara is a rich historic landmark; it spans more than 300 years. Its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in the French and Indian War, the American Revolution and the War of 1812. The gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort. At dusk, there will be an exciting Traditional Native American Dance Show, ‘Thundering Water Cultural Show’, and the night will be ended with the beautiful native singing and the gorgeous traditional dancing! [\(The completeness of night view on certain summer evenings may be limited or not](#)

available due to late sunset time and the US Federal Government regulations on driving hours.) When night falls, we will return to the hotel.

Day 4: Niagara Falls – Toronto, Canada (12/25 Sunday)

In the morning, guests will continue sightseeing in the Niagara Falls. We will cross the border to Canada through the Rainbow Bridge. You will also watch “Niagara: Legends of Adventure”, a dramatic 45-minute IMAX film which will further discover the culture and history of the Niagara Falls! (Customers would see the movie at U.S. side if Day 3’s time allowed) Take the ride to the top of the Skylon Tower which is 775 feet above the falls! Relax and enjoy your meal at the 360 degree Revolving Dining Room. After lunch, guests will arrive in Toronto - the largest city and financial center of Canada - in the afternoon. The CN Tower will be the first stop here, we can take photo of it from outside. Around the corner of CN Tower is the Ripley’s Aquarium of Canada. It holds over 16,000 fantastic aquatic animals, featuring with North America’s longest underwater viewing tunnel (96 meters) which allow you to walk by the Sharks, Rough tail Stingrays, and dangerous lagoon. Guests will be both entertained and inspired to protect the waters of the world. We will also see the Ontario’s Provincial Parliament which completed in a Romanesque style in 1893 and then the modernist styled City Hall which consists of two arc-shaped high-rise blocks, 20 and 27 stories high respectively, whose stunning structure makes it another popular landmark. Furthermore, view the Spanish style castle Casa Loma from outside. Then we will go to the historical Chinatown to have dinner. It is one of the largest Chinatowns in North America, located in downtown Toronto, where you will find authentic Chinese food!

Day 5: Toronto – Ottawa – Montreal (12/26 Monday)

In the morning, we will reach Canada’s Capital and political center, Ottawa. Here we will visit the National War Memorial, Parliament buildings and Peace Tower with the height of 295 feet. Canada’s Parliament buildings are commonly viewed as the one of the most magnificent government centers in the world with firm stone exterior and vivid setting on the cliffs! The buildings consist of the House of Commons, the Library of Parliament, the Hall of Honor, the Senate, and the impressive Peace Tower. After a short stay, we will drive to the Montreal, known as “Paris of North America”, a French-speaking and second largest city of Canada. The famous Olympic Tower together with the Olympics stadium has become the symbol of the city. The 175-meter inclined tower leans at a 45-degree angle and functions as an observation deck with a funicular that whisks passengers to the top in 95 seconds. Amble around and soak up the European charm of the Old Montreal, you will marvel at how you can step back in time at every cobblestone corner. Along the way, we will pass by the grand Notre-Dame Basilica. Lastly, a plenty of dinner options in Chinatown will bring you a satisfactory end of the day!

Day 6: Montreal – Quebec (*) – Boston (12/27 Tuesday)

In the morning, we will go to another beautiful French style city, Quebec. Everything in the town such as the street signs, cafes, buildings, people’s dressing look and the atmosphere will tell its rich French descent. As you wander past period buildings along cobblestone streets, enjoy the area's boutiques, art galleries, and restaurants. A visit to Place Royale is like a step back in time to the early days of New France. The Ramparts of Quebec City are the only remaining fortified city walls in North America north of Mexico, with close to 4.6 km of walls and imposing gates to explore. Visit the Notre-Dame de Quebec Basilica-Cathedral and you will see a large number of pieces of art. You will also have chance to take pictures with the world’s most photographed hotel Chateau Frontenac and the Parliament Building as well as enjoy an authentic French cuisine. We will have a short stay at duty-free stores, then head to Boston, a cultural city rich in American history. Upon your arrival, it’s time for dinner and you will be recommended with its famous fresh lobsters feast - get excited! (*In case of delays by U.S. Customs and Border entry procedure, you may have other meals instead of the lobster dinner.)

Day 8: New York City Tour (12/29 Thursday)

Nowadays it is still the most famed landmark of the city. In addition, Guests will take a sightseeing cruise tour on the Hudson River to enjoy the city view from a completely different angle, as well as take pictures with the backdrops of Statue of Liberty and Brooklyn Bridge. Furthermore, visit U.S.S INTREPID, the national heritage that costs \$120 million, which is reopen for visitors. Concorde supersonic airliner and a variety of aircrafts will be in the exhibition. In addition, wandering around the world's famous financial and securities trading center – Wall Street, taking pictures with the New York Stock Exchange and its signature sculpture Charging Bull, and visiting Trinity Church, Times Square, Madame Tussauds’, and Ripley’s Believe It or Not - all of them will be made up into our tour later. Of course, we cannot miss the renowned Metropolitan Museum of Art. The Metropolitan Museum of Art is the largest art museum in the United States with more than 2 million works of art collection. In the end of the day, our tour bus will pass by the Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller Center, United Nations Headquarters, Ground Zero and the new “Freedom tower”, One World Trade Center. Certainly, Broadway musicals are one of the most celebrated symbols of the city. You will have a chance to watch the world class Broadway shows of opening after 7:00PM upon your request. Anyone who is under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.) Next, we will go shopping at the world's finest outlet – Woodbury Common Premium Outlets. The merchandises will be on sale for 25% to 65% savings with assorted designer and name brands such as Burberry, Coach, Dolce & Gabbana, Fendi, Prada, etc.

Day 10: New York Times Square Countdown (12/31 Saturday)

In the morning, guests will see Columbia University, Lincoln Performing Arts Center, Fifth Avenue Christmas animation window exhibitions and so on. After enjoy a leisurely lunch, we are heading to the Times Square countdown area, and celebrating New Year with thousands of visitors. Meanwhile guests can watch performances before the countdown. At the same time, roads of countdown zone will close for pedestrian only; you can freely enjoy the bright lights of Times Square and experience the world-famous New Year street celebrations to witness the historic moment. After the end of the countdown, guests can choose to return to the hotel to rest or enjoy a free drop-off service directly to the three major airports (LGA / JFK / EWR), taking flight after 4:00 AM on 1 January 2017, only if the room is not occupied on that night (count by room), Tour Admission is unchanged. If room is occupying, and drop-off service is needed for guests who shared the room, will be charged \$20/ person, tour guides will accept applications on our tour bus.

2. Flights after 2:00PM: Free airport drop-off service to three major airports (LGA, JFK or EWR, EWR is highly recommended). Passengers of flights before 7:00PM will NOT go shopping.

3. Flights after 7:00PM, tourists can choose:

A. Go shopping at the Jersey Garden Outlet. The merchandises will be on sale for 20% to 70% savings with assorted designer and named brands.

B. Experience to fly a plane at their own expense. (Participants must be at least 14 years old. Ages 14-18 need to be accompanied by an adult guardian.) Each participant will have approximately 60 minutes flight experience including 15 minutes pre-flying examination & instruction on the ground, 45 minutes driving a private aircraft. Participants are flying with FAA authorized flight instructor on the aircraft; 3 people can experience driving the same aircraft, switching seats after stopping at airport. Participants do not need pilot's license and prior flying experience, and will be authorized a "First Flight" certificate.

C. Experience shooting at own expense. (Participants must be at least 12 years old. Ages 12-18 need to be accompanied by an adult guardian.) Experience time is around 60 minutes, including 15 minutes principle explanation and shooting instruction. Each participant will have an opportunity to experience a 9mm caliber pistol and rifle, three shooting range targets, a box of 9mm ammunition (50 rounds). Each participant will receive a commemorative T-shirt and a set of protective gear.
