Absolutely, you will like the "Niagara: Legends of Adventure", a dramatic 45-minute IMAX film on the new screen (45 feet × 25 feet), to discover the history and culture of the Niagara Falls. Afterwards, you can choose either: A. to self-explore the Falls Park until returning to the hotel. B. to take Niagara Falls In-depth Tour (**Tour fee: \$25/person, including \$13 of the admission ticket**). This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder - Niagara Whirlpool State Park and the U.S. historic landmark - Old Fort Niagara. The Niagara Whirlpool’s greatest depth is 125 feet. It has estimated the whirlpool formed approximately 4,200 years ago by the upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by Niagara River. Old Fort Niagara is a rich historic landmark; it spans more than 300 years. Its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in the French and Indian War, the American Revolution

and the War of 1812. The gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort. At dusk, there will be an exciting Traditional Native American Dance Show, 'Thundering Water Cultural Show', and the night will be ended with the beautiful native singing and the gorgeous traditional dancing! Furthermore, visit U.S.S INTREPID, the national heritage that costs \$120 million, which is reopen for visitors. Concorde supersonic airliner and a variety of aircrafts will be in the exhibition. In addition, wandering around the world's famous financial and securities trading center – Wall Street, taking pictures with the New York Stock Exchange and its signature sculpture Charging Bull, and visiting Trinity Church, Times Square, Madame Tussauds', and Ripley's Believe It or Not - all of them will be made up into our tour later. Of course, we cannot miss the renowned Metropolitan Museum of Art. The Metropolitan Museum of Art is the largest art museum in the United States with more than 2 million works of art collection. In the end of the day, our tour bus will pass by the Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller Center, United Nations Headquarters, Ground Zero and the new "Freedom tower", One World Trade Center. After the end of the countdown, guests can choose to return to the hotel to rest or enjoy a free drop-off service directly to the three major airports (LGA / JFK / EWR), taking flight after 4:00 AM on 1 January 2017, only if the room is not occupied on that night (count by room), Tour fee does not change. We will offer free airport pick-up service in Seattle during 9:00AM-10:00PM. ### **(Morning tour: Flight arrivals before 12:00PM) Microsoft Corporate Headquarters – University of Washington**

Founded in 1975, Microsoft is the worldwide leader in software, services, devices and solutions that help people and businesses realize their full potential. Guests will have a chance to visit the famous Building 92(Microsoft Corporate Headquarters) to learn Microsoft's fascinating history and everything about one of the world's largest and most influential company. (Inside tour; tours are subject to closures for private events.) Also, we will go to University of Washington, commonly referred to as UW, a public flagship research university based in Seattle. Founded in 1861, UW is one of the oldest universities on the west coast and features one of the most highly regarded medical schools in the world. A new model for learning, collaborating and problem solving - the Global

Innovation Exchange (GIX) has been launched here between two leading research universities, the University of Washington and Tsinghua University, with foundational support from Microsoft. It should also be reminded that the campus is famous for appreciating Cherry blossom.

**(Night tour: Flight arrivals before 6:00PM) Seattle Fisherman Wharf – Kerry Park**

We will firstly travel to Seattle Great Wheel, which is a giant Ferris wheel at Pier 57 on Elliott Bay in Seattle, Washington. With an overall height of 175 feet, it was the tallest Ferris wheel on the West Coast of the United States when it opened on June 29, 2012. Next stop is Kerry Park where visitors can have a panoramic city view of the entire Seattle. It is a perfect location for photography and if you see Space Needle with a backdrop of Mount Rainier in any marketing photos of Seattle, this is exactly where to take the pictures. In addition, the park was one of the many stops on the finale episode of the third season of Amazing Race

**Day 9: Olympia, WA – Portland (1/2/2017 Monday)**

Visit Olympia, the capital city of the State of Washington, to see the state house. Travel north to Columbia River Gorge in 40 miles to the east of Portland. The Columbia River is the 4th largest river by volume in the nation, flows inside the Rocky Mountains. It covers and runs for 1000 miles along the border of two states, Oregon and Washington. The magnificent view of the valley includes Multnomah, a famous 620 feet falls. Next stop is Portland where we will visit the International Rose Test Garden, which was built in 1917 for the worldwide rose experiment. You can always see new types of roses growing here. Later we will visit The Grotto. With 62-acre green space of fir trees, colorful rhododendrons and other native plants, The Grotto is an inviting destination for all as an internationally-renowned Catholic shrine and botanical garden. A circular path which is called Stations of the Cross near the parking area leads visitors to the 14 bronze bas-relief sculptures. The heart of the shrine is Our Lady's Grotto, a rock cave carved into the base of a 110-foot cliff.

**Day 10: Florence Beach – Sea Lion Caves (1/3/2017 Tuesday)**

After breakfast, we will drive along the West Coastline where you can enjoy the view of Pacific Ocean and the coastline. Florence Beach has been called the "North American Sahara Desert". You can take a special sand buggy ride within the dunes of the beach. Then visit the Sea Lion Cave which was eroded by the waves and the formation began about 25 million years ago. Sea Lion Caves is America's largest sea cave and the year-round home of the Steller sea lion, but sea lions are not always in the Cave. They are wild animals so these protected animals come and go as they please, as is their nature. Also you can learn more of their nature and habitats. Hotel:

**Day 12: Seattle City Tour (1/5/2017 Thursday)**

Seattle is the largest city in both the State of Washington and Pacific Northwest region of North America. Here, we will bring you to take a tour inside Boeing factory located in WA. Being the largest aircraft manufacturer in the world, at its factory you will learn the history of aircraft making as well as see one of the four huge Dreamlifters in the world; there will be professional Boeing employee guiding you to tour the Boeing Assembly Plant inside the world's largest building (by volume) to watch Boeing 747, 777 and 787 Dreamliner jets being assembled. Boeing can build a miracle in only 3 days, so get ready to widen your eyes with an unparalleled experience. Next, we will go to Pike Place Market which opened over a hundred years ago and is one of the oldest continuously operated public farmers' markets in the United States. Originated by farmers for selling their

products, the Pike Place Market is now one of the major tour attractions in Seattle, holding about 200 commercial events every year and exhibiting 190 kinds of handcrafts by 120 agriculture vendors plus street performers. It is worth noting that the first and original Starbucks store opened here in 1971. After strolling around the market, we will head to Space Needle. Space Needle is an observation tower and an icon of Seattle. It was built in the Seattle Center for the 1962 World's Fair. On top of the tower you are offered with free telescope to see the amazing view of not only Seattle city but also Puget Sound and Mt. Rainier. Another surprise will be the "Teleporter" kiosks that were created and collaborated between the Space Needle and Microsoft. Using Microsoft Photosynth technology and content shot by Creature, the 520 Teleporter offers a 3D experience that can't be found anywhere else. Then we will visit the EMP museum located at the foot of Space Needle. EMP stands for Experience Music Project. EMP is the first commercial project that Frank O. Gehry, the avant-garde architect, has designed in the Pacific Northwest. Founded by Paul Allen the Microsoft cofounder, EMP Museum is dedicated to the ideas and risk-taking that fuel popular culture. Three thousand panels, made up of 21,000 individually cut and shaped stainless steel and painted aluminum shingles, encase the stunning outside of the building. In the end, we will complete the Seattle's tour by visiting the Pioneer Square. Pioneer Square is Seattle's Original neighborhood since 1852. Naturally, this historical community has experienced many changes over the course of time dating back to the Gold Rush, featuring the perfect balance of old coexisting with new.
