Day 1: Hometown – Chicago (Night Tour) (12/25 Sunday)

The first day itinerary is for your reference only; the schedule is subject to change upon your arrival.

Our professional tour guide will meet guests at the baggage claim area of O'Hare Airport and there will be scheduled shuttle bus for the guests to go to the hotel. (Complimentary pick-up service of O'Hare airport is available between 9 AM and 9 PM. For the other time, charged pick-up service is available for the first two persons at \$120 with \$10 for each additional person. No pick-up service is available at Midway airport.) Day 2: Chicago City Tour (12/26 Monday)

This tour will show you the best of Chicago in one day. You will take a walk in the Millennium Park, a combination of stunning architecture, sculpture and landscape design located in the heart of downtown Chicago, where is one of the best public spaces that you can find on earth; go through Cloud Gate, the impressive signature urban sculpture of Chicago. Take a break at the Clarence Buckingham Memorial Fountain, one of the world's largest artificial fountains, and at the Navy Pier, the former Navy training center, which is the most visited lakeshore park in central United States now. Another stop is Michigan Ave, the Magnificent Mile, where the Art Institute of Chicago, Grant Park, shopping malls and boutique stores, and the historical Chicago Water Tower are located. To have the best view of this famous city, you will go up to the 360 CHICAGO which soars 1,000 feet above Lake Michigan and the city's majestic skyline to offer the most breathtaking views of downtown Chicago, the lakefront and four neighboring states: Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Wisconsin. It newly presents an enclosed, glass and steel moveable platform that tilts outward 304 meter above the Magnificent Mile and safely holds up to eight visitors at a time, which will be another thrilling experience for whom like to challenge themselves. Next, you will visit the Shedd Aquarium, one of the oldest and the largest indoor aquariums in the world with a diverse animal collection ranging from Pacific to Amazon River, From Philippines to the Great Lakes. Famed for its bold architecture, it has a skyline bristling with skyscrapers. Chicago is also the birthplace of skyscrapers. A walk tour is one of the best ways to learn more about this famous architectural city. No worries for the harsh weather in winter. We will show you how to explore the city through the famous Pedway - Pedestrian Walkway System which connects numerous famous architectures in the city.

Day 3: Chicago – Detroit (12/27 Tuesday)

Day 6: New York City (12/30 Friday)
