Participants are flying with FAA authorized flight instructor on the aircraft; 3 people can experience driving the same aircraft, switching seats after stopping at airport. Participants do not need pilot's license and prior flying experience, and will be authorized a "First Flight" certificate.
- C. Experience shooting at own expense. (Participants must be at least 12 years old. Ages 12-18 need to be companied by an adult guardian.) Experience time is around 60 minutes, including 15 minutes principle explanation and shooting instruction. Each participant will have an opportunity to experience a 9mm caliber pistol and rifle, three shooting range targets, a box of 9mm ammunition (50 rounds). Each participant will receive a commemorative T-shirt and a set of protective gear.
