Day 1 Chicago – Detroit (12/27 Tuesday)

In the morning, we are heading to the capital of automobiles, Detroit. We will stop at the headquarters of the General Motors Company and take pictures. We will then visit Henry Ford Museum, which is sponsored by the Ford Motor Company. It is the second– largest carmaker in the United States. It's said that where cars exist, there is a Ford. The exhibitions not only show the history of Ford but also reveal the process of American Industrial Revolution. The collection contains many rare exhibits including John F. Kennedy's presidential limousine, Abraham Lincoln's chair from Ford's Theatre, Thomas Edison's laboratory, the Wright Brothers' bicycle shop, and the Rosa Parks bus. Day 4 New York City (12/30 Friday)
