## **Itinerary**

Day 1

NYC- Philadelphia -Hotel

Hotel : Days inn/ Sleep Inn, MD or equivalent

Departure from New York in the morning, we will head to Philadelphia.

First, we will visit **One Liberty Observation Deck**, which is the only observation deck in Philadelphia. Guests will stand on the shoulder of Philadelphia's 'giant', Benjamin Franklin, to see the historic city through a splendid 360-degree view. We can see William Penn's statue standing on the top of city hall which reminds us about the Quakers' creed in this city: the city of brotherly love.

We will leave One Liberty Observation for the **Reading Terminal Market** for lunch. You cannot visit Philly and miss out on visiting the Reading Terminal Market. The variety of food, delis and restaurants in this one spot is overwhelming. If you prefer Chinese Food for lunch, China town is just around the corner.

And then we will go for **the City Hall of Philadelphia** (outside view). Right next to it would be the **"Love" sculpture**, designed by Robert Indiana, was first placed in the plaza in 1976 as part of the United States' Bicentennial celebration. It was removed in 1978, but the sculpture was missed, and the chairman of Philadelphia Art Commission, Fitz Eugene Dixon Jr., bought the sculpture and permanently placed it in the plaza, in 1978.

At last, we will go to visit the **Museum of Philadelphia**. Take Photos with Rocky Step and Washington Monument Fountain. It was originally chartered in 1876 for the Centennial Exposition. The museum administers collections containing over 240,000 objects including major holding s of European, American and Asian origin. *Vase with twelve Sunflowers* by Van Gogh, *The Bathers* by Paul Cézanne.

### Day 2 Washington DC- Cherry Blossom Cruise

Departure from the hotel in early morning, we will spend the day visiting Washington D.C., the capital of the United State.

First, we will visit National Air and Space Museum. The Air and Space Museum on the business street recorded the development of the aerospace industry. There are the Wright Brothers' aircrafts in 1903, modern out space exploration, St. Louis's Lindbergh's Spirit and the real Apollo 11 cockpit. The sightseeing of the trip also included the White House (outside view), America's seat of governing power. When we are standing in front of the Capitol Hill, the congress building in retro style will totally leap into our eyes. We will go to the Lincoln Memorial, where we can honor this notable past president and consider the impact he had in our history. From the Jefferson Memorial, there will be specular view in every April as the Cherry Blossom blooming along the Tidal Basin. Donated by Japan as a gesture of friendship and peace, the Cherry Blossom trees in DC have graced the Tidal Basin and Potomac Waterfront for over 100 years. And the guest will have the chance to take the D.C. Cherry Blossom Cruise for sightseeing along the Potomac River. With a backdrop of full blooming cherry trees on the banks of the Potomac River, you can also see most iconic landmarks in the area: the Pentagon, Washington memorial, Air Force Memorial and so on... The cruise offers a best way to view the capital city being surrounded by cherry blossom!

If time permits, we will be visiting the Madame Tussands in Washington D.C. which is the only attraction you can get close to the "45 presidents" of US. We will have the chance to explore the inner structure of The White House, taking photographs with Oval Office desk aka The Resolute Desk. The great names will be memorized and honored forever. By the end of the day, our tour will head back to New York metropolitan area. After the In-depth tour of Washington D.C., we will head back to New York City.

#### **Special Note**

Each year, the National Cherry Blossom Festival celebrates spring in Washington, DC. As for this year, the official schedule is March 20 – April 15, 2018. However, the view of the cherry blossom is subject to change due to weather conditions. Furthermore, reservation is not available for the Cherry Blossom Cruise based on the busy season in D.C. The cruise tour is subject to change regarding the cruise company's schedule as well as the tourist volume. In case that cruise was not in service, we will go to the renowned Madame Tussauds' President Gallery instead.
