Day 1: New York - Washington D.C. - Cherry Blossom Cruise

Departing from New York in the morning, we are heading to our nation's Capital, Washington D.C. The sightseeing of the trip may begin with the White House (outside view), America's seat of governing power. When we are standing in front of the Capitol Hill, the congress building in retro style will totally leap into our eyes. We will go to the Lincoln Memorial, where we can honor this notable past president and consider the impact he had in our history. From the Jefferson Memorial, there will be specular view in every April as the Cherry Blossom blooming along the Tidal Basin. Donated by Japan as a gesture of friendship and peace, the Cherry Blossom trees in DC have graced the Tidal Basin and Potomac Waterfront for over 100 years. And the guest will have the chance to take the ***DC cherry blossom Cruise** for sightseeing along the Potomac River. With a backdrop of full blooming cherry trees on the banks of the Potomac River, you can also see most iconic landmarks in the area: the Pentagon, Washington memorial, Air Force Memorial and so on... The cruise offers a best way to view the capital city being surrounded by cherry blossom!

If time permits, we will be visiting the Madame Tussands in Washington D.C. which is the only attraction you can get close to the "44 presidents" of US. We will have the chance to explore the inner structure of The White House, taking photographs with Oval Office desk aka The Resolute Desk. The great names will be memorized and honored forever.

Day 2: Annapolis - Navy Academy - Adventure Aquarium - New York

Depart from Hotel in the morning for the United States Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland. Walk along the same old brick sidewalks as George Washington or Thomas Jefferson did back when Annapolis was considered the original capital of the United States. We will continue to the Visitor Center (require photo ID for entrance), where America's Naval forces train in readiness for defense. The United States Naval Academy (also known as USNA, Annapolis, or Navy) is a four-year coeducational federal service academy located in Annapolis, Maryland, United States. Established in 1845 under Secretary of the Navy George Bancroft, it is the second-oldest of the United States' five service academies, and educates officers for commissioning primarily into the United States Navy and Marine Corps. The entire campus is a National Historic Landmark and home to many historic sites, buildings, and monuments. And then we are going to visit the most famous aquarium in New Jersey-" Adventure Aquarium". Immerse yourself in the watery world and get ready to experience the life aquatic at the Adventure Aquarium on the Waterfront. Now you can get hands-on, touch and more interactive than you've ever imagined with these creatures of the sea. There are more than thousand kinds of sea creature in the aquarium, such as sea turtle, seal, shark, and penguin. Passing through Maryland, Delaware, and New Jersey, our bus will safely take you back to New York City at the evening.

Each year, the National Cherry Blossom Festival celebrates spring in Washington, DC. As for this year, the official schedule is March 20 – April 16, 2017. However, the view of the cherry blossom is subject to change due to weather conditions. Furthermore, reservation is not available for the Cherry Blossom Cruise based on the busy season in D.C. The cruise tour is subject to change regarding the cruise company's schedule as well as the tourist volume. In case that cruise was not in service, we will go to the renowned Madame Tussauds' President Gallery instead.
