Itinerary

Day 1

Philadelphia - Basilica of the National Shrine - Franciscan Monastery - ICE! @ National Harbor - National Christmas tree

Reference Hotel: Radisson Hotel Baltimore Downtown or equivalent

Depart from Philadelphia, we will visit the **Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception**, which is the largest Roman Catholic Church in the U.S. and is one of the ten largest churches in the world. Byzantine-Romanesque in style, its massive, one-of-a-kind superstructure is home to over 70 chapels and oratories that relate to the peoples, cultures and traditions. We also visit the Holy Land: **Franciscan Monastery**, the grounds and monastery include many replicas of the iconic sites in the Holy Land.

Then head to Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center's amazing **ICE! Christmas** on the Potomac Indoor Ice Festival. Enjoy more than TWO MILLION pounds of hand carved colorful ice sculptures kept at a chilly 9 degrees, experience two-story ice slides, visitor also can travel through the North Pole, sit inside Santa's sleigh

We will continue to visit the National Christmas Tree in front of the White House south lawn. The grand illumination of the Christmas lights on the tree by the President of the United States early in the Christmas season is an annual televised event and the start of month-long festivities known as the Pageant of Peace. Nearby smaller trees and other decorations leading up to the National Christmas Tree are referred to as the Pathway to Peace.

Day 2

Amish Village - Longwood Gardens - Philadelphia

Heading north, we visit the authentic **Amish village** in Lancaster, PA, which is more than 300 years old, and is a truly an educational experience for the whole family. This 25-acre farm is dedicated to showing people about the Amish lifestyle in a fun and constructive way.

No holiday is complete without a visit to **Longwood Gardens**, where's one of the world's most celebrated horticultural displays, Longwood Gardens showcases more than 11,000 different types of plants and flowers amid 1,050 acres of outdoor gardens and woodlands.

At last, we will return to Philadelphia.
