Day 1	New York - Secret Caverns - Niagara Falls Hotel : Sleep Inn /holiday inn, Buffalo airport or equivalent

Guests will be picked up in New Jersey and New York in the early morning. We will head north to Secret Caverns in upstate New York. We will then continue to Niagara Falls, NY where we will **see IMAX Movie** and the **Niagara Fall Night View**.

Day 2 Niagara Falls – Corning Glass Museum

We will then continue to explore Niagara Falls; Guests will have the chance to have a **Niagara Falls In-depth Tour** that includes visits to the *Whirlpool State Park* and *Old Fort Niagara*. We will then head to Corning Glass Museum. This museum in western New York is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. Its collection contains more than 45,000 objects, some of which date back millennia.

Day 3 Washington D.C. –Cherry Blossom Cruise- Philadelphia

Departing from hotel in the morning, we are heading to our nation's Capital, Washington D.C. The sightseeing of the trip may begin with the **White House** (outside view), America's seat of governing power. When we are standing in front of the **Capitol Hill** (outside view), the congress building in retro style will totally leap into our eyes. We will go to the **Lincoln Memorial**, where we can honor this notable past president and consider the impact he had in our history. Next to the Jefferson Memorial, there will be specular view in every April as the Cherry Blossom blooming along the Tidal Basin. Donated by Japan as a gesture of friendship and peace, the Cherry Blossom trees in DC have graced the Tidal Basin and Potomac Waterfront for over 100 years. And the guest will have the chance to take the **D.C. Cherry Blossom Cruise** For sightseeing along the Potomac River. With a backdrop of full blooming cherry trees on the banks of the Potomac River, you can also see most iconic landmarks in the area: The Pentagon, Washington memorial, Air Force Memorial and so on. The cruise offers a best way to view the capital city being surrounded by cherry blossom!

After lunch, we will go to Philadelphia to visit **Independence National Historical Park**. Independence Hall (outside view) is primarily known as the location where both the Declaration of Independence and the United States Constitution were debated and adopted. And we also have a close look of the Liberty Bell, an iconic symbol of American Independence. Our bus will safely take you back to New York City in the evening.

Special Note :

Each year, the National Cherry Blossom Festival celebrates spring in Washington, DC. As for this year, the official schedule is March 20 – April 15, 2018. However, the view of the cherry blossom is subject to change due to weather conditions. Furthermore, reservation is not available for the Cherry Blossom Cruise based on the busy season in D.C. The cruise tour is subject to change regarding the cruise company's schedule as well as the tourist volume. In case that cruise was not in service, we will go to the renowned Madame Tussauds' President Gallery instead.
