**\*\*Itinerary highlight: Pratts Falls Country Park, The Strong Museum, George Eastman House, Rochester Museum & Science Center.**

### Day 1:

In the morning, we drive to the Pratts Falls County Park to see the Pratt's Falls. The centerpiece of this county park is its sole falls. Although it resides in a deep narrow gorge, covered in trees, it is seen perfectly framed by foliage from the provided lookout area half-way down the gorge walls feed a slight echo to the 137 feet high cascade, spreading the tranquil sound of the tumbling water to the adjacent areas of the park. Then we drive to the Rochester, we visit the Strong museum, is part of The Strong in Rochester, New York, Established in 1969 and based initially on the personal collection of Rochester, NY native Margaret Woodbury Strong, the museum opened to the public in 1982, The National Museum of Play is the only collections-based museum anywhere devoted solely to the study of play, and although it is a history museum, it has the interactive characteristics of a children's museum making it the second largest museum of that type in the United States.

### Day2:

We come to the high falls, which is one of tree voluminous waterfalls on the Genesee River, that through the city of Rochester, the high falls are located about 2 miles upstream from the lower falls and act as their source. We would walk close to the bridge to see the whole view of the fall.

Then we come to the , George Eastman House, George Eastman is the founder of Eastman Kodak Company, and the museum is the world's oldest museum dedicated to photography and one of the world's oldest film archives, opened to the public in 1949, World-renowned for its photograph and motion picture archives, the museum is also a leader in film preservation and photograph conservation, educating archivists and conservators from around the world. Finally, we come to the Rochester Museum and Science Center, The Rochester Museum and Science Center, or RMSC, is a museum features many exhibits related to science. These include Adventure Zone, the newly expanded Expedition Earth, How Things Work, Inventor Center, and other traveling interactive exhibits, in addition to the permanent historical galleries.
