(Passengers, who arrive at Terminal 7 @ JFK, please wait at the Passenger Waiting Area outside of the baggage claim.) Service fee for the complimentary airport pick-up: \$10/person. 3. If customers claimed their baggage at other time, we can arrange the paid pick-up service. 24- hour paid pick-up service is available for the first 1-2 persons at a total of \$120 with \$10 for each additional person. 4. For customers need to gather at airports by themselves: If the customer is not able to arrive on time, please contact us or your agent 1-day prior to the departure day.
