Daytona Beach is a city in Volusia County, Florida. The city is historically known as having a beach that the hard packed sand allows vehicles to drive on the beach in limited areas. This hard packed sand made Daytona Beach as the Mecca for motorsports, which has hosted races for over 50 years in the past. This Daytona Beach course was replaced

by the Daytona International Speedway in 1959. The city is also the headquarters for NASCAR and the Grand American Road Racing Association. *Hotel: Comfort inn, Best Western or equivalent.*

Day 3: Theme parks in Orlando (Monday, 12/21)
