Then you can choose either to stay in the Falls Park for self exploration until returning to the hotel or have an in-depth tour (\$ 25/Adult) by visiting the Hydropower Station and Old Fort Niagara. Come to the Old Fort Niagara, it will give you all the insights 99% tourists would never discover.
